

The Companion Events Department is excited to announce our **fifth** Junior Agility Competition in conjunction with the AKC Agility Invitational to be held at the Orange County Convention Center in Orlando, Florida. Competition will be held **Friday, December 11, 2015**.

- Entry Limitations – Limited to 100 dogs (2 dogs maximum per junior handler)
 - Entries will open **Wednesday, July 29, 2015 @ 8:30 am PST**
 - Entries will close **Monday, September 28, 2015 @ 6:00 pm PST**
 - Wait list will be kept until **Monday, September 28, 2015**
- Entry Fees - \$25.00 for Junior Agility Competition; \$10.00 for Time-2-Beat (reduced fee for juniors)
- Junior Eligibility Requirements
 - Competitor must have an AKC Junior Handler number prior to entering.
 - Junior Handler numbers can be requested at
 - http://www.akc.org/kids_juniors/jrnoform.cfm.
 - For dogs without an agility title from AKC or any recognized agility organization they will need to have a **Competition Ready form** signed by their trainer that confirms the dog is able to perform all obstacles safely and off leash. 4-H Members who do not have an AKC title or a title from any recognized agility organization on their dogs must have a **Competition Ready form** signed by their project or club leader who works with the member and their dog to confirm they are ready for competition.
 - The dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather or grandmother, including the corresponding step and half relations, or by a permanent member of the Junior Handler's household. According to the *Junior Showmanship Regulations*, Section 7. Eligibility of Dog.
 - Handlers must be under 18 years of age on the day of the competition.
- Eligibility of Dogs
 - All dogs must:
 - Be a minimum of 15 months old on the day of competition
 - Have an AKC Number or
 - Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privilege (PAL/ILP) <http://www.akc.org/reg/ilpex.cfm> or
 - Foreign registration number and country for an unregistered imported dog
 - Identification number issued by AKC
 - AKC Canine Partnerssm Program Listing Number. The AKC Canine Partnerssm Program is for all dogs, including mixed-breed dogs. Any dogs enrolling with the AKC Canine Partnerssm Program to compete at this event will have their \$35 registration fee waived.  - Have an AKC jump height card or they will be measured on Friday morning prior to the competition and will be moved to the correct height class if necessary.
