### Remembering Yesterday, Focusing on Tomorrow

The Britton-Macon Area School Educational Foundation was formed to enhance educational opportunities of the Britton-Macon Area School, including scholarships for Britton-Macon students, alumni, and teachers, special projects, and capital improvements to the Britton-Macon campus. The foundation falls under the umbrella of the Lenawee Community Foundation. Having the Britton-Macon Area School Fund within the community foundation has advantages to both the school and contributors to the fund. Investments and reporting are handled by the Lenawee Community Foundation, thereby leaving the Britton-Macon Area School to its primary mission of education and raising funds to enhance educational opportunities within the school. In addition to contributors helping those opportunities become realities, contributors qualify for both federal and state tax benefits.



The Britton-Macon Area School Educational Foundation accomplished its goal of completing the track/football field complex. This year a new lighting system, scoreboard and home/visitor seating for 1,000 spectators was added. The field was dedicated during a community wide celebration on September 8, 2006.

This project was the first major endeavor of our Foundation. We are pleased with the progress that we have made, however we are mindful of the fact that there remains much to be done. We have established the following goals for our Foundation.

- Create an alumni support group to provide funding and volunteers for future projects
- Secure funding to develop the district's environmental Landscape for Learning Project
- Continue the support of our fine arts department
- Provide funding for teacher mini-grants that promote growth for our students
- Provide scholarship opportunities for students


