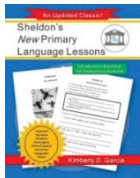
Bible Handwriting Practice Series

Handwriting Practice: From the Bible! Book 1 Handwriting Practice: From the Bible! Book 2

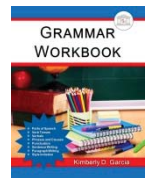
Sheldon's New Primary Language Lessons



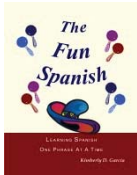
