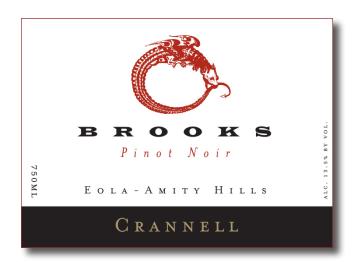

CANDIED CHERRY, CRANBERRY, RASP-BERRY AND BRIGHT STRAWBERRY FRUIT ON THE NOSE. TOUCH OF TOMATO LEAF, WATERCRESS AND DILL HERBAL NOTES.

BEAUTIFUL STRUCTURE AND BALANCE, WITH A LAYERING OF BRIGHT FRUIT, REFRESHING ACIDITY AND A LONG FINISH. THE FRESH HERBS ADD AN ADDITIONAL LAYER OF COMPLEXITY TO THE FLAVORS OF ORANGE PEEL, RHUBARB, STRAWBERRY, CRANBERRY AND RAINIER CHERRY FRUITS. A SLIGHT EARTH CHARACTER, WITH GREEN TEA SPICE, MOSS AND MUSHROOM NOTES. LOVELY COMBINATION OF FRUIT AND STRUCTURE AND VERY PLEASANT AND COMPLEX TO SIP.

A GOOD PAIR WITH PROSCIUTTO STUFFED CHICKEN, SAUSAGE AND MUSHROOMS, VEAL SALTIMBOCCA AND MUSTARD CRUSTED PORK TENDERLOIN.
