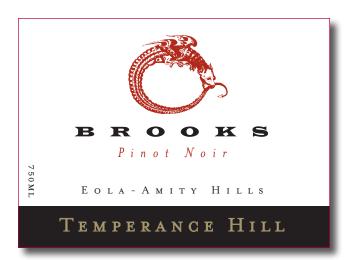

BOUQUET: FRESH CANE BERRIES, VIOLET, LIC-ORICE, CHERRY BLOSSOM, BRULEE

PALATE: BLUEBERRY, RED APPLE SKIN, CLOVE, CINNAMON OIL, SATSUMA, SHAVED FENNEL

PERCEPTION: FIRM TANNINS AND BRIGHT ACIDITY LEAD INTO AN ELEGANT AND LONG FINISH

DRINKABILITY: SHOWING READINESS AND COMPLEXITY THAT WILL CONTINUE TO DEVELOP WITH AGE.

2015 VINTAGE: A WARM WINTER YIELD-ED BUD BREAK THREE WEEKS EARLIER THAN NORMAL AND LEAD INTO BLOOM UNDER EXCEPTIONAL WEATHER CONDITIONS. A DRY AND HOT SUMMER WAS BROKEN UP BY RAIN IN LATE AUGUST, AND FAVORABLY COOLED DOWN IN SEPTEMBER IN TIME TO RESULT IN ONE OF THE EARLIEST HARVESTS ON RECORD. THE GRAPES AT HARVEST WERE EXTRAORDINARY IN QUANTITY AND QUALITY, OFFERING RIPENESS, BALANCE, AND EXPRESSIVE FLAVOR.
