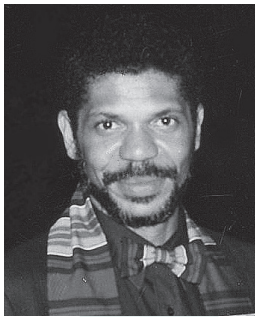
New CAPA Logo

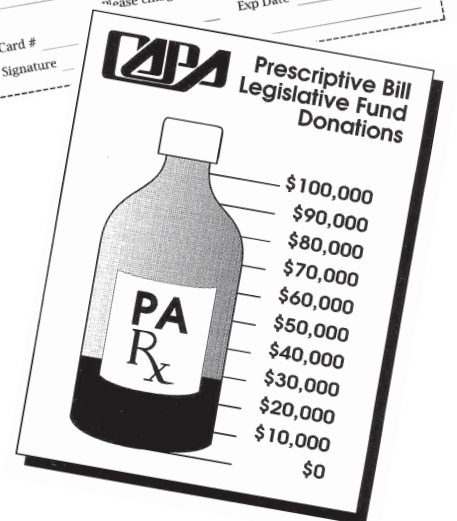
