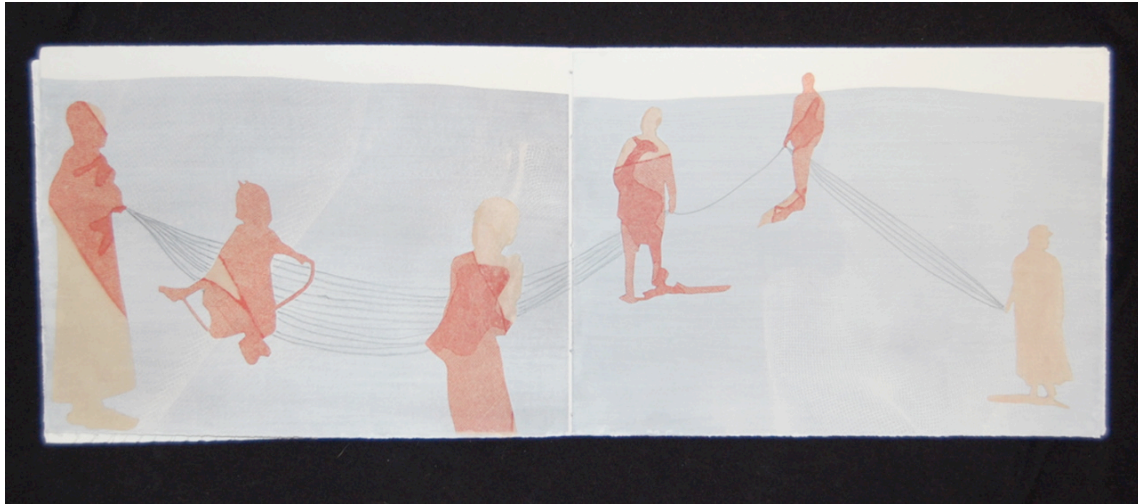


## My Figures Fail to Tell Me How Far the Village Lies by Sarah Zidonik
