Management is a modulation of the desert landscape that renders the physical effects of watershed management in the Southwest. The work serves to document the history and state of the area by directly referencing the contrast before and after damn building in the Grand Canyon, Yosemite and Hetch Hetchy Valley areas. By reducing mountains, valleys, and canyons to calculated units the artist, Kate McHugh, renders the physical effects of watershed management and it's importance on the desert community. For in an area with scare resources, management techniques often significantly alter the sensitive landscape.
