CSBDRM REQUIRED CLASSES

DR ORIENTATION: Southern Baptist Disaster Relief is Christian love in action as DR volunteers meet the urgent needs of hurting humanity in crises. This class will teach you the history of Southern Baptist Disaster Relief, the definition of a disaster, types of disaster services offered, partner organizations, how volunteer callouts of works, and how we show compassion in crises. This is a required class for certification as a DR volunteer.

OPERATIONAL STRESS FIRST AID (OSFA): OSFA is a process for the timely assessment and preclinical care of stress reactions or injuries in volunteers or units. This class is required of all Southern Baptist Disaster Relief volunteers across the nation.

CERTIFICATION CLASSES

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT: Working under the supervision of the White or Blue Cap leading a disaster relief response, the Administrative Assistant manages on-site office procedures and other tasks as assigned. Computer skills are necessary bring your laptops, tablets, smart phones.

CHAINSAW TRAINING: Crews safely cut damaged or dead trees that might endanger lives.

DR CHAPLAINCY: DR Chaplains offer non-threatening spiritual care for disaster victims and survivors through active listening, meeting basic needs and stabilizing crisis reactions. They provide resources for effective coping, stress management and spiritual wellness.

CLEANUP & RECOVERY: Cleanup & Recovery training includes various kinds of debris removal, temporary repairs, and site cleaning to restore individuals and churches to life after a disaster.

HEAVY EQUIPMENT: Classroom, CAT and Skid-Loader: a CSBDRM trained and certified heavy equipment operator will lead participants to safely, efficiently and effectively use various types of equipment including forklift, skid steer, excavator or other vehicles used to clean disaster sites.
* prerequisite class is Cleanup & Recovery.

LAUNDRY UNIT: provides knowledge needed to set up washers and dryers, do laundry as well as close down the unit. Laundry services also may be provided for disaster survivors and/or DR team members.

MASS FEEDING: Through classroom and hands-on training, volunteers will learn to prepare and serve meals during disaster deployment.

SHOWER UNIT: provides knowledge to safely set up, operate, properly clean and close down the unit.
