DR Chaplaincy: offers non-threatening spiritual care and emotional support to disaster survivors as well as team members. This discipline also provides resources for effective coping, stress management and spiritual wellness.

DR Orientation: Southern Baptist disaster Relief is Christian love in action. As DR volunteers meet the urgent needs of hurting humanity in crises. This class will teach you the history of Southern Baptist Disaster Relief, the definition of a disaster, types of disaster services offered, partner organizations, how volunteer callouts or works, and how we show compassion in crises. This is a required class for certification as a DR volunteer.

OSFA, Operational Stress First Aid: OSFA is a process for the timely assessment and preclinical care of stress reactions or injuries in volunteers or units. This class is required of all Southern Baptist Disaster Relief volunteers across the nation.
