Those interested in working in a disaster area through Southern Baptist Disaster Relief must complete an orientation training course along with at least one of the focused training classes. Volunteers meeting these requirements and completing a background check will receive a California Southern Baptist Disaster Relief identification badge, a gold DR hat and tee shirt which is recognized as the Southern Baptist uniform only to be worn when deployed with a team working under Blue and White Hat leaders. This training event is for new volunteers, for those who desire to be recertified or for those who are currently certified and wish to take additional training.

CERTIFICATION CLASSES

Friday Schedule

Registration, check-in (includes ID Badge picture) and continental breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m. Lunch is included.

CHAPLAINCY: Friday and Saturday, 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM (2 Days)

This training for DR chaplaincy is related to non-threatening spiritual care and emotional support for disaster survivors and team members. This discipline also provides resources for effective coping, stress management and spiritual wellness. This class includes the required New Volunteer Orientation and Operational Stress First Aid (OSFA).

FEEDING AND LOGISTICS: Friday and Saturday, 8:00 AM – 4:30 PM (2 Days)

The first section of training for the Feeding Team is to complete the required New Volunteer Orientation which will be presented Friday morning. This session is followed by three separate classes. After Orientation, you will be asked to choose ONE of the THREE classes listed below that will be conducted 10:45 AM--2:30 PM.

1. **FEEDING 101** is the basic feeding class which equips participants to serve effectively in a feeding kitchen. The class covers food safety, personal responsibility, sanitation, and managing warehouse/inventory.
2. **FEEDING 102*** is a **new** advanced feeding class and explores food safety in greater depth, allow participants to deepen their feeding skills and ability to strengthen the feeding response team. *Feeding 101 is a prerequisite for this class.
3. **LOGISTICS/MAINTENANCE** is a **new** class that prepares participants to handle propane/diesel fuels, electrical and other needs necessary for setting up mobile kitchen, shower and/or laundry trailers. Safety issues, set-up concerns and other aspects of the Logistics/Maintenance team will be addressed.

2:30 PM – 4:30 PM

Feeding 101, Feeding 102 and Logistics/Maintenance classes all combine to set up a mobile kitchen trailer. Saturday these three classes will work together to complete kitchen setup, prepare lunch, tear down and pack kitchen trailer.

Saturday Schedule

Registration, check-in (includes ID Badge picture) and continental breakfast begins at 7:30 a.m. Lunch is included. *Chaplaincy and Feeding classes continue from Friday.*

ORIENTATION AND ADMINISTRATION: 8:00 AM - 12:15 PM

Orientation is REQUIRED for all new volunteers and recertification. This class is NOT for people who are attending Chaplaincy and Feeding classes since this material is covered in class. Administration session equips attendees to use the SBDRM app (FormStack) and support the team while in the field. Bring smart phone or tablet to practice while in the class. After lunch, you will attend ONE of the THREE classes listed below that will be conducted 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM.

1. CLEAN-UP/RECOVERY

This class prepares participants to perform ash-out or mud-out cleanup jobs. Specific information about each clean-up process is taught.

2. SHOWERS/LAUNDRY MINISTRY

Participants learn how to conduct the ministry of providing showers and laundry services to disaster survivors as well as other team members. This class focuses on the ministry related to providing these services rather than the mechanics of setting up the trailers.

3. INCIDENT COMMAND SYSTEM

This class gives basic structure and use of the Incident Command System to safely and effectively guide the response teams in ministering to disaster survivors. This is valuable for Blue Hats and includes a table-top exercise.
