- ___ 1. Teaching assistants need to be briefed on the basics of first aid and CPR or know of a competent individual who will be available to function in this role if needed during scheduled class and lab times. **It is recommended that all TA's take first aid training.**

- ___ 2. A list of chemicals, including MSDS forms, and equipment to be used throughout the course is provided to each teaching assistant.

- ___ 3. The teaching assistant should possess the ability to use all of the equipment and chemicals in a safe manner and have the ability to demonstrate safe use and handling to the students that are being instructed.

- ___ 4. The instructor/professor must witness the proficiency of each graduate student TA, and approve that they are competent, in the area of chemical handling and equipment operation relevant.
