#### **International Presentations/Meetings**

I was instrumental with the initial contacts with Minia University and Cairo University in Egypt. These contacts resulted from my presentations to the administrators and faculties at both universities in the spring of 1993. These presentations were conducted as part of the developmental process of the initial formation of official agreements between North Dakota State University and Minia University and Cairo University in Egypt. These agreements were signed officially in November 1994. A group of NDSU faculty traveled to Egypt for the signing process. I was part of this official delegation as I was the creator of the agreements.

During summer of 2001, I spent 16 days in South Africa at the University of Fort Hare as an invited expert in Distance Education Technologies in course development and course delivery. I

was invited to deliver three formal presentations to all faculty and administrators concerning distance delivery technologies. It was then my responsibility to develop a faculty training, course design and course deployment strategy. I then presented this to faculty and administrators. I then was responsible for the initial set-up of the course distribution servers, provide a faculty training program in course design and development, and to design of video conferencing infrastructure for the University of Fort Hare campus. I continue to interact with the faculty and to assist in solving problems or concerns. A follow-up visit is planned for 2004 or 2005.

I have also been working with the University of Botswana for the past 5 years in designing a total e-Learning video conferencing system. This includes initial wiring and equipment for the main campus and its 3 branch campuses. I was responsible for providing initial training materials and to develop a faculty train-the-trainer program. A CD-ROM has been developed and produced for faculty training as well as on-site visits to train-the-trainer first hand.

During the summer of 2004 I was asked to go to Africa with the Director and Associate Director of International Programs to establish additional linkages with University of Botswana, Botswana College of Agriculture, and Jomo Kenyatta University of Agriculture and Technology. During these visits we talked about how to increase collaboration and faculty student exchanges between our universities as well as directions for future proposals to funding agencies.

I spent 21 days in November and December 2004 working as a consultant for UNESCO on an international project with the University of Liberia. This project was to work with and develop a new or revised teacher education training program for future teachers. I was asked to serve as expert consultant on designing a Teacher Education program as well as an implementation plan for the University of Liberia. This project was coordinated through the UNESCO office in Paris. During this time, I was responsible for designing an Academic Development Center for current teacher educators in the nation of Liberia.

During November 2006 I spent 8 days working on a project in Yerevan, Armenia. The scope of the project is to assist the State Agrarian University of Armenia convert to a university aide credit based system. The project was funded by the Foreign Agricultural Service and is a joint project between Texas A&M, Pennsylvania State University, and Michigan State University ( I was appoint as an Adjunct Faculty in International Programs at MSU). My responsibility was to determine the needs and procedures for extension and distance education programs to make the conversion.

In January 2007 I started a 6 month sabbatical leave to the United Arab Emirates. My scope of work was to work with the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research Commission for Academic Accreditation in developing national program standards for e-Learning programs and for Technical and Vocational Education. This included handbooks and documents required for licensure and accreditation of institutions already existing or coming into the U.A.E. as new universities. Zayed University and the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research funded my sabbatical.



In March 2012, I spent 15 days working for a CNFA – USAID project in Pristina, Kosovo. My scope of work was to assist in evaluating and recommending a train the trainer program for the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Rural Development in Advisory Services (Extension Service). Mainly to evaluate the current situation and to assess the needs analysis to determine an effective training program for new and existing extension agents. These to serve the agriculture sector in Kosovo.
