

## Suggested Packing List for Campers!

This list indicates the kind and quantity of items the average guest will need during their stay at camp. It is meant as a guide, and it is not necessary that guests have each item in the quantity suggested. Always check the weather before leaving home and adjust accordingly!

The camp will provide: sheets, blankets and pillowcases.

### The usual going away kind of things...

- 1 Towel (don't forget your towel!)
- 1 Wash cloth
- 1 Bathrobe
- 1 Pair of shower shoes or flip flops
- 1 Heavy sweater or jacket
- 1 pair of sneakers
- 3 Pairs of socks
- 1 Pair of pajamas
- Undergarments
- Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, shampoo, conditioner
- Make up and other toiletries
- Comb/brush
- Sunscreen
- 1 Pairs of jeans or long pants
- 1 Pair of shorts if it's warm enough
- 1 Raincoat or poncho
- Other casual wear: Tshirts and sweatshirts esp. if you'd like to hike
- Sturdy shoes or hiking boots for hikes
- Sunglasses
- Hat
- \*\*Flashlight
- Alarm clock
- Water bottle

It can get cold at night, bring a Sleeping bag or blanket.  
If you want to be extra comfy, bring a foam pad to sleep on.

### Music and Dance camp type of stuff

- Dance wear for workshops
- Soft-soled dance shoes
- Drums & other musical instruments

Costuming & back up ipod with your music if you're performing

Hafla/dance wear - feel free to dress up!

Cash or cards - there will be vending by Pyaara, DWebb and more!

- Camera
- Cell phone charger
