The Spring Valley location recently donated boxes for shipping supplies to relief efforts in Haiti.

Founded in 1972, San Diego Self Storage is one of the largest self-storage providers in San Diego County with a network of 15 neighborhood self-storage facilities and additional facilities in Los Angeles and Orange County. The company is locally owned and operated and offers small personal units and multiple larger units for commercial accounts.

The Spring Valley location recently donated 100 corrugated boxes for shipping supplies to benefit earthquake victims in Haiti. The boxes transported items collected at the Light of the World Church, including clothing, medical supplies, food and water.
