STEPS	INFORMATION
1. STOP: Engage the mind on the task at hand	List task to be performed:
2. LOOK: Identify the hazards in the immediate work area and those associated with performing the task Address Manage Look Stop	Place a check mark next to hazards present: Struck Against — Can a worker strike anything? Struck By — Can anything move and strike a worker? Contact — Can a worker come in contact with live energized equipment? Caught-In — Can any part of a worker be caught on any object that could pull them into equipment? Fall/Same Level — Can a worker slip or trip on anything that could cause a fall? Fall/Different Level — Can a worker fall from one level to another? Overexertion — Can a worker be injured while lifting, pulling, pushing, twisting, reaching, bending or another motion? Exposure — Can a worker be exposed to excessive noise, vibration, extreme temperatures, poor air circulation, toxic gases, fumes, dust, or hazardous chemicals?
3. ADDRESS: Act to eliminate, control or reduce hazards	List methods used to address hazards:
