Keyport Bible Church Missionary of the Week

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ,

Much has happened here in the last month including some of our greatest opportunities yet to communicate the gospel and build up the church at large in this part of the world.

In mid-March, we were privileged to host Paul Washer (and his son Ian) in Croatia. Paul was the featured speaker in an annual conference on the northern coast of Croatia called "There is Hope." This conference has been going for over a decade and is designed to build up and encourage gospel ministers in this part of the world to keep on serving faithfully in often times difficult ministry. In the past, the conference maxed out at 150 people, but this year because of interest in Paul's ministry there were well over 300 people. Prior to the conference, we hosted a meeting in Zagreb on Wednesday night where Paul preached twice and allowed us to interview him. At this meeting there were between 700-800 people, much larger than any meeting we have ever hosted in the past. Finally, on Sunday after the conference we organized joint services in the morning and afternoon with several churches within driving distance and had again in excess of 500 people.

Paul had a burden to explain the gospel in as much detail as possible in order to build up and encourage pastors and evangelists in this area so that they might continue to preach and teach the power of God to their churches, families, and neighbors. Despite significant health challenges, God was faithful to sustain and strengthen His servant during his ministry here. (News: Paul suffered a significant heart attack this last Monday in the states, but is expected to be released from the hospital soon - Please keep him in your prayers.)

Please pray that God would bring much fruit as a result of this ministry and that God would continue to use Paul Washer as he serves the church with his passion and clarity. We were able to make several new contacts for potential students. Please pray that God would give us a solid group of new students in the Fall.
