Keyport Bible Church Missionary of the Week

Dear Keyport Bible Church,

Thanks for your generous giving to feed the starving here in Malawi. What a blessing you are to them. Please pray for safety as we distribute the food. We will start the first week in February.

We have enough money for 217 bags of maize and I have a good source for it.

Monday we buried our sweet teenage girl, Nsada. She was coming on weekends to learn sign language, and on the weekdays she came to play with my girls. Nsada suffered with HIV and her sister and aunts often played doctor or (witchcraft) on her. Most recently she had a tumor or swelling in her cheek, so the aunts operated. Three days later she was dead. We will miss her laughter and sweet smile.

I seem to have another bone spur making its way out of my gums, so will most likely travel to South Africa to have it looked at. That way if more surgery is needed, they can do it there. For sure, they will be qualified to do the work.

I was recently informed that Christina's grandmother is coming here from Mozambique to take Christina back there. We are preparing our hearts to say goodbye. I am heartsick but Christina has had difficulty bonding so it may be for her best. I do not want her to resent being here. Christina has been learning many praise and worship songs, so I'm trusting they will stick with her. Her mother is selling donuts and prostituting herself, which apparently is her norm. I do not want to see Christina rejected by her mother, so perhaps this is best.

My Mom and I are doing as well as can be expected. Mom sleeps a lot and I am trying to ignore my jaw issues until I can see a better doctor in South Africa. My brother, Bill, will be here on the 22nd of this month for a week. I'd like to go see the doctor between Bill's visit and Chris's yearly visit on February 15. Thanks for your prayers. Blessings to All.
