Keyport Bible Church Missionary Updates

Dear Friends,

We have 22 students in our Bible College this semester. Jerry is teaching a class on Church Administration to five fourth-year students. The students have been involved in several missions trips. During Holy Week, 6 students went with one of the professors to Argentina and Paraguay. They were involved in personal and corporate evangelism. Last weekend, 5 students went to a small city in Uruguay called Frey Bentos. They were also involved in evangelism and teaching. This weekend (April 29-30), several more students are helping out a church plant in the city of Canelones. There are plans to take a group to Peru during the month of July, when there are no classes at the college.

We also have a project that we would like to see completed next year. We are planning to buy three sea containers and recondition and install them on some property owned by one of the mission boards. They would be divided into three class rooms, two dormitories for male students and several bathrooms. We are estimating that the total cost will be around \$60,000.

We passed out around 5,000 tracts in the neighborhood around our church, during Holy Week. We are praying for the Lord to use His Word to speak to people's hearts.

During Holy Week, Linda and I made an emergency trip to Indiana, to visit her older brother, who is not doing well health-wise. Please pray for Ed, that the Lord would heal him and that he would grow in his new-found faith. We didn't have classes in the college during this week, so we were free to make the trip.

Thank you so much for your prayers for and giving to our ministries in Uruguay.
