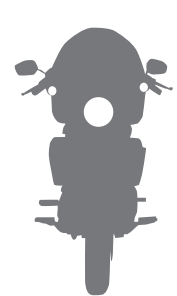


# MOTORCYCLES IN MISSOURI



**153,120** registered motorcycles (including trikes and autocycles)

**369,032** licensed motorcycle drivers (as of 1/4/19)



## Helmets

reduce the chance of fatal injury by **42%** and reduce the risk of sustaining a head injury by **69%** for motorcycle riders.

Missouri could see a **38% INCREASE** in fatalities if the helmet law is repealed.

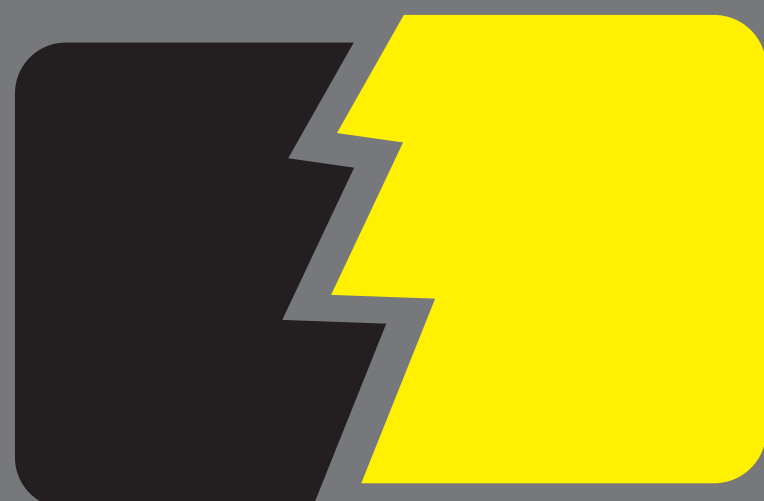

## Watch for MOTORCYCLES

In addition to the tragic loss of life and impact to individual families, crashes result in an annual economic loss in Missouri totaling nearly **\$9.9 million** per fatality. (U.S. DOT).



### 2017 MOTORCYCLE FATALITIES



**50%** of motorcycle drivers killed were either **unlicensed** or **improperly licensed**.



**47%** of motorcycle drivers killed were **speeding**.



**19%** of motorcycle drivers killed were **substance-impaired**.
