Cellphones contributed to **2,470** crashes in Missouri in 2016.

Reported crashes involving cellphones increased **11%** in 2016.



Texting increases the risk of a car crash by **50%**.

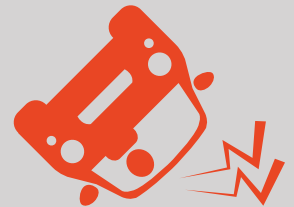
You are **23X MORE LIKELY** to be in a **crash** when a driver texts and drives.

Missouri is **ONE** of **THREE** states without an all-texting ban.

1,020 minor injuries

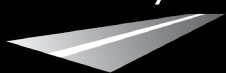


24 of these crashes occurred in **WORK ZONES**.
