Frequently Asked Questions

Who is the Treehouse for?

The Treehouse is our elementary ministry, for children in kindergarten through 5th grade.

When do I drop off my children?

The Treehouse meets during our service time at 11 AM on Sunday mornings. Check in for Kids Ministries begins at 10:35 AM and ends at 11:10.

What happens in the Treehouse on a Sunday?

In the Treehouse children are split into Community Groups of 6-10 kids for small group activities that focus on teaching your kids about Jesus. Community Group Leaders lead these activities.

For the Worship Gathering part of the service, we sing and dance! Following the musical worship, all children sit through a Worship Teach where a Treehouse Teacher reads from the *Jesus Storybook Bible* (more info about this below).

Children also have a snack time after worship where they are given a small snack. Community Group Leaders use this time to ask review questions and have a short share time where the children can share about their weeks.

We also play fun games and share a lot of laughter!

What do you teach?

We want children to experience the love of Jesus and learn to follow Him! In the Treehouse we introduce the Gospel and teach what it looks like to have a personal relationship with God.

We use the *Jesus Storybook Bible* Curriculum to teach your children on Sunday mornings.

What are the evacuation plans?

In the unlikely event that we need to evacuate the building, volunteers will exit with the children through the Terraces rear exit doors. Volunteers will not release children to anyone without a matching security pick-up tag.

What if my child needs me during service?

During check in, all children are given name tags with a security number, while parents receive a tag with the matching security number. Parents are to keep their tag with them during the service. If a parent is needed for any reason, we will page them by placing their security number on the screens during the service. We ask that the parent then report immediately to the Treehouse.

How do we keep the Treehouse safe?

All volunteers have passed a background check process. Also, the only people permitted in the Treehouse room are Treehouse children, Treehouse parents, and kids ministry volunteers. Parents are required to show the security tag upon pick-up and have to present their security tag in order to retrieve their children.

We also have a security volunteer guarding the Kids Ministry hallway at all times in case of emergency and to assist in case of evacuation.

How can I help in the Treehouse?

We always have volunteer opportunities in the Treehouse!
