'Early Robin' has the potential to be one of the most profitable cherries yet growers struggle to consistently set fruit.

Join growers from around the region for this tour and hear what is working and what isn't from growers with experience.

STOP 1: Hayden Farms

4th leaf on 'Gi12' and 'Gi6'; Y-trellised

Meet 1/4 mile north of 3190 Cottonwood Dr.

Head N on Road 68, keep right on Taylor Flats Road; Turn Left on Sagemoor; Turn right on Cottonwood.

STOP 2: Todd Wilmoth

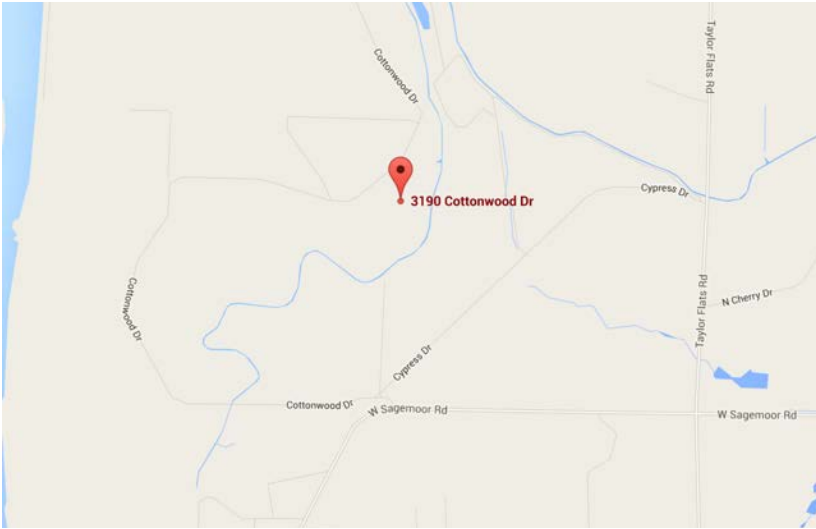
Mature block on 'Gi5' and 'Gi6'; Y-trellised; rain covers

S. Oak St and E 45th Ave is nearest intersection. Go west on E 45th Ave off S. Oak

STOP 3: Olsen Brothers

5th leaf on 'Gi6' and 'Gi5'; Y-trellised UFO

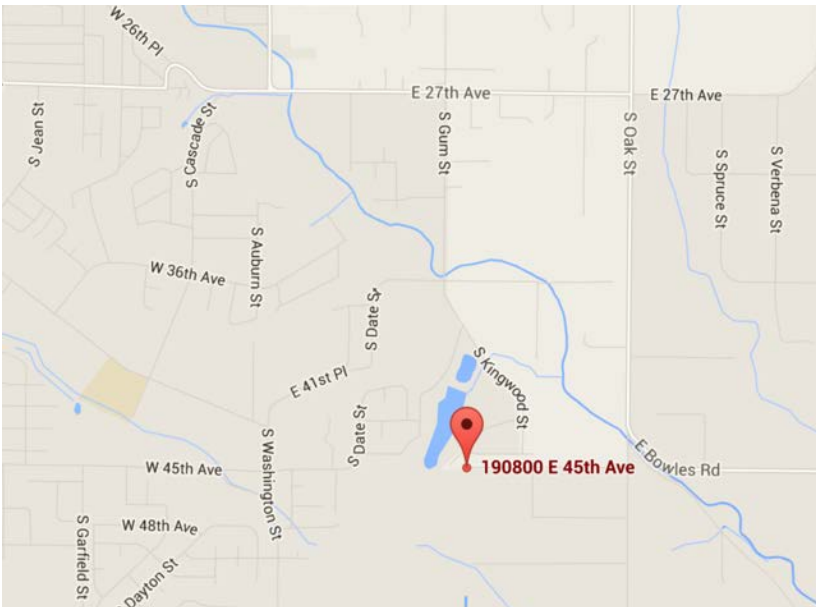
Turn north on District Line Rd off O.I.E. from Benton City. Turn west on gravel road at top of hill.



Stop 1: Hayden Farms

9:00 am

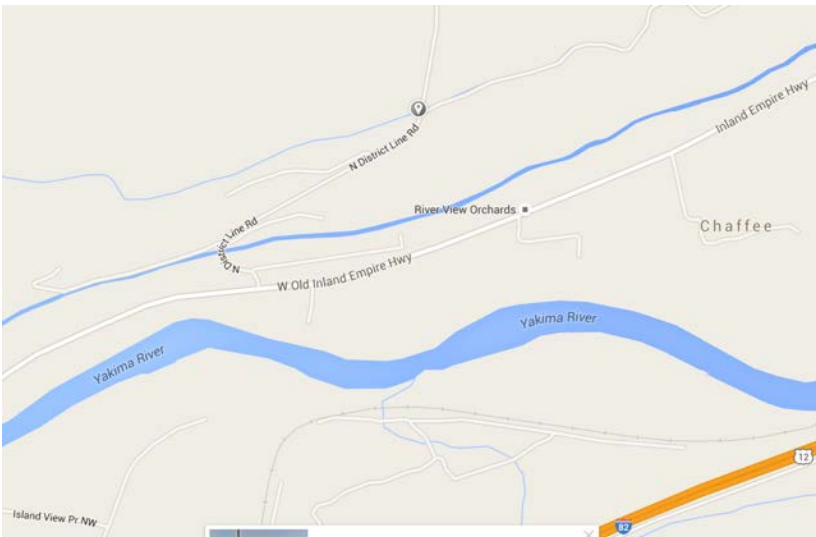
Enter off Cottonwood Dr. 1/4 mile north of 3190 Cottonwood Dr.



Stop 2: Wilmoth Farms

10:30 am

Turn west on E 45th Avenue off S. Oak St.; follow the road around, past houses to the orchard.



Stop 3: Olsen Brothers

11:30 am

Enter off North District Line at the top of the hill. Follow gravel road to the west about 1 mile to orchard.
