James Lovell, b. in Barnstable, Mass., IO-23-I692; d. 5-25-I76I; m. at Barnstable, Mass., IO-25-I716, Abigail, dau. of Shobael Gorham, who was descended from John Howland and Elizabeth Tilley, both of whom came over in the Mayflower. One of the eleven children of James Lovell and Abigail Gorham was:

5. Daniel Levell, b. at Barnstable, Mass., 6-20-1722; d. 8-9-1785; m. at Vineyard Haven, 10-3-1745, Sarah Beetle, who d. 1-9-1808. He was a soldier in the French and Indian Wars. One of their eight

children was:

6. Christopher Levell, b. at Barnstable, Mass., 4-30-1750; d. 5-6-1838;

m. Ist, Abigail, dau. of Thomas Sturgis, II-25-1774. (For Sturgis line see Freeman's History of Cape Cod.) One of their 6 children was:

7. Oliver Lovell, b. at Barnstable, Mass., 3-17-1787; d. at Glens Falls, M. N.Y. 1864; m. at Boston, Mass. II-5-1809, Clarissa Downes, whose father, Jesse Downes, was a Revolutionary soldier. (For Downes line see Huntoon's History of Canton, Mass.) The youngest of the six children of Oliver Lovell and Clarissa Downes was:

8. Eliza Maria Lovell, b. at Cincinnati, Ohio, 8-5-1823 (or 1824); d. at Summerland, Cal. 7-14-1898; m. Ist, I2-6-1842, James B. Summons. They had two children: James Blair Lovell Summons, who was well and favorably known in Riverside as Jimmie Summons, and Eliza, who d. in early childhood.

Eliza Lovell Summons was m. at Jersey City, N.J., I2-II-1865, to

Luther Calvin Tibbets.

9. James Blair Lovell Summons, b. at Cincinnati, Ohio, 4-4-1845; d. at Los Angeles, Cal.1018-1909; m. Ist, Harriet Emery Tibbets, dau. of Luther Calvin Tibbets by his Ist wife. She d. at Riverside, Cal. 12-5-1876. Their only child, Daisy Alice Summons, b. at Fredericks-burg, Va. 8-15-1867; drowned in the Santa Ana River, near Colton, Cal. 4-20-1878.
