Dear Mr. Shriver;

I am writing to express our organization's intent to participate in the 1994 AIDS Dance-A-Thon, sponsored by your organization. We are pleased to participate again in this successful fund-raiser, and will agree to make the necessary "seed" money payments in November and December totaling \$5,000, in order to receive the 10,000 grant award through your Community Grants program.

GAPA Community HIV Project provides a broad range of services for the Asian and Pacific Islander populations of San Francisco. It is the only agency which can provide comprehensive, culturally appropriate services to gay and bisexual men and to Asians and Pacific Islanders with HIV. We are currently engaged in a process to merge our agency with the Asian AIDS Project, a prevention based organization serving the A/PI communities. It is our intention that the missions of both organizations will be better served through this merger, and ultimately, our communities will be better served. Organizational capacity related to fiscal management is a critical need for our organization in order to handle a budget which will be much larger than our current size of \$700,000. In order to manage the volume of contracts, expenses, and cash flow necessary to support this larger organization, we are prioritizing fiscal planning and management for use of the Community Grants funds.

We value MAA's work and our inclusion within the AIDS Dance-A-Thon, which would be a significant portion of our general operating support in providing direct services to Asians and Pacific Islanders with HIV infection, and preventing HIV infection among gay and bisexual A/PI men in the San Francisco Bay Area. Funds from the Community Grants Program will be used towards strengthening the organizations ability to provide these services, such as increasing our capacity to maintain public funding contracts and cash flow; and increasing our ability to increase private contributions.
