## **Guidelines to Joining with us in Faith.**

- A. You need to get some Rhema on the situation. God needs to speak to you about this so you can have Faith.
  - 1. This will produce Hope: 'A Joyful, Confident, Expectation of Something Good.'
  - 2. It will produce Faith: 'Sureness & Certainty'.
  - 3. Then you call into existence, what he told YOU he wants to happen in this.
  - 4. Once you hear the Spirit, obey what he's saying you should do regarding the situation.
  - 5. Don't Give Any Room For Fear.
    - a. Choose to believe what God has said to you, not something else.
    - b. Fear is the mind and emotions believing in and expecting that something bad (the worst) could or will happen.
      - It will run scenarios. It gives you mental images.
- B. We have received. From our perspective, we own this healing and recovery.
  - 1. That's how we're approaching it. (Hebrews 11:1 Amp.)
  - 2. Faith does not need a doctors statement to determine if she is cancer free.
    - a. That's putting our faith in the physical sign more than God's Word.> 1 Cor. 5:7 We walk by faith, not by sight.
    - b. We eventually want physical confirmation, but the outcome is being determined now. We're Not waiting until then and see what will happen.
- C. This is how we are Posturing ourselves in all of this.
  - 1. By Faith: Mary does not have cancer.
    - a. Heb. 11:1 (Quote) Sure / Certain; Title Deed; Perceiving as Fact what is not revealed to the senses.

- 2. She had a diagnosis of it, but since then we have received Her healing and it's done. Now we simply let God accomplish that in her.
- 3. So to join in faith > Don't say she has cancer.
  - a. Don't use the principle of Rom. 4:17 against Her.
  - b. We have received, so By Faith the cancer is gone.
  - c. When people say she has cancer they are calling those things that are not as though they were. (You're calling cancer back on her)
    Romans 4:17 principle in reverse.
- 4. Let me say it this way: If we are believing she is healed, when can God

actually heal her if we keep claiming she still has cancer?

If it is when the doctor says there's no cancer, then were walking by sight and not by Faith.

That is the exact opposite of what the word tells us how we're supposed to approach this.

- 5. If you are going to say something, call her whole, being healed, healed by faith, standing for her healing, believing for her healing, etc.
- 6. If you can't say something in agreement with Faith, don't say anything at all.
  - a. Example: Israelites taking Jericho.
  - b. Really guard your heart and mouth.
- D. Faith not accompanied by action is dead. (James 2:17 NIV)
  - 1. We are also pursuing some Natural and Alternative solutions.
- E. Please do not feel sorry for us, pity us, cry for us out of sympathy, say things like 'this is so sad'. etc.
  - 1. Think about this:
    - a. To have Faith you must first have Hope. Hope is: (Gr. Definition)

'A Joyful, Confident, Expectation of Something Good'.

- 2. How can you have a Joyful, Confident, Expectation of Something Good:
  - a. And be in sorrow, pity, sympathy, sadness, depressed, etc.
  - b. They are not compatible.
    - To be sad, sorrowful, depressed, self-pity, etc.
      - > We can't have Hope. Therefore we have no Faith.
    - To have Hope & Faith we can't live in sorrow, pity, sympathy, sadness, depression, etc.
- 3. We don't want to hear it or see it.
- 4. You will not see it or hear it in us.
- F. I have had an overwhelming Peace from the beginning of this whole thing.
  - 1. Let me (us) live in the Peace we have been given.
  - 2. When we are not worried, fearful, anxious, stressed, etc.
    - a. Don't try to talk us into it worry, fear, pity, etc.
    - b. Don't think something is wrong with us if we are not that way.
    - c. Some people like drama, and need to be stirring emotions and making everything a big deal. (How hard this must be, feeling sorry for us, etc.)
    - d. We don't need your drama. We're asking you to join us in Faith.
  - 3. As God speaks to you and gives you Hope and Peace, don't let that peace go. Guard it and hold onto it as being part of your standing in Faith with us.
  - 4. Some people will say: they don't grasp that kind of Peace.
    - a. They say it's normal for a person to be afraid, worry, struggle, cry & feel bad, etc.
      - > If you have Hope, those things are not normal for God's Kingdom.
    - b. It's OK if they don't get it. However, I will remain in the place so I do get it and live in it.

Philippians 4:4, 6-7 (NIV)

[4] Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! [6] Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. [7] And the peace of God, which transcends ("Passeth" - KJV) all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

5. The real peace that comes from God won't be understood by people who do not have that same revelation of God and his Peace.

## G. As we go through this:

I will try to be very pastorish in all of this. Teaching and helping others to understand.

But realize, if we cut you off in something you are saying, correct you, you feel like I'm rebuking you on something that you are saying or doing in regards to Mary and her healing, etc. -- Please don't pick up an offense.

We are standing for her life. This is not a game. The stakes are very high on this. We simply won't entertain anything that could cause doubt, fear, unbelief, etc. And before we listen to it in order to be nice to you, we will stop you.

- H. What we fall short on in Faith, we believe his Grace and Mercy will cover. (Heb. 4:16)
  - 1. We are setting our Faith to receive her complete physical Healing and Health.
  - 2. That's the goal. That's what we're going for.
- I. Please don't use our children as informants.
  - 1. If you have a question: Ask Us.
  - 2. We've told them they don't owe you an answer, and they may not give one to you.
