2. The proposal will be forwarded to the Director of USST and the
Undergraduate Faculty Program Coordinator for review.
3. If the project is approved you would be provided a faculty code
to enroll in CSE 496 or 498 with your faculty mentor.
4. In some cases, you may be appointed an Allen School faculty to
co-sponsor your project if that is determined by the Undergraduate
Faculty Program Coordinator. In this scenario students would be
given the faculty code of their co-sponsor to enroll in CSE 496 or
498.

1. Write a brief proposal that describes
the research project, its connection to
CSE, and that includes your faculty
mentors information. Send the proposal
to ugrad-adviser@cs.washington.edu.
2. The proposal will be forwarded to the
Director of USST and the
Undergraduate Faculty Program
Coordinator for review.
3. If the project is approved you would
be provided a faculty code to enroll in
CSE 499 with your faculty mentor.
