Campus Buildings, 1949-1963

After the campus moved to its location on Hillsborough St. in 1926 building construction remained stagnant for over two decades. Not until 1949 did the campus experience growth through the construction of new buildings. Between the years 1949 and 1963, under Carlyle Campbell's administration, several new



buildings were added to campus. Our contemporary campus would not be recognizable without this significant era of building and facilities construction.
