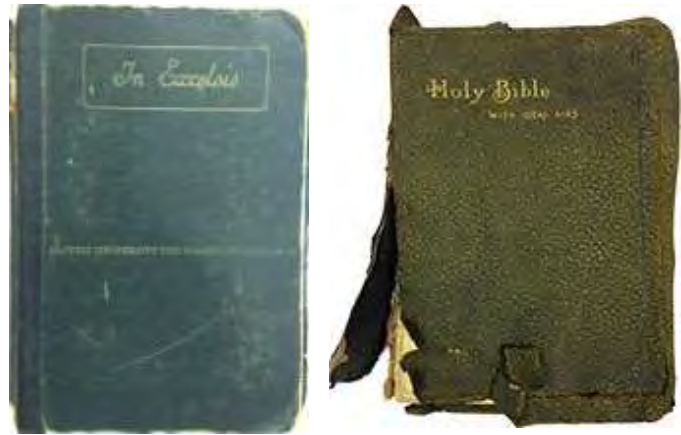


### Chapel and Religious Life

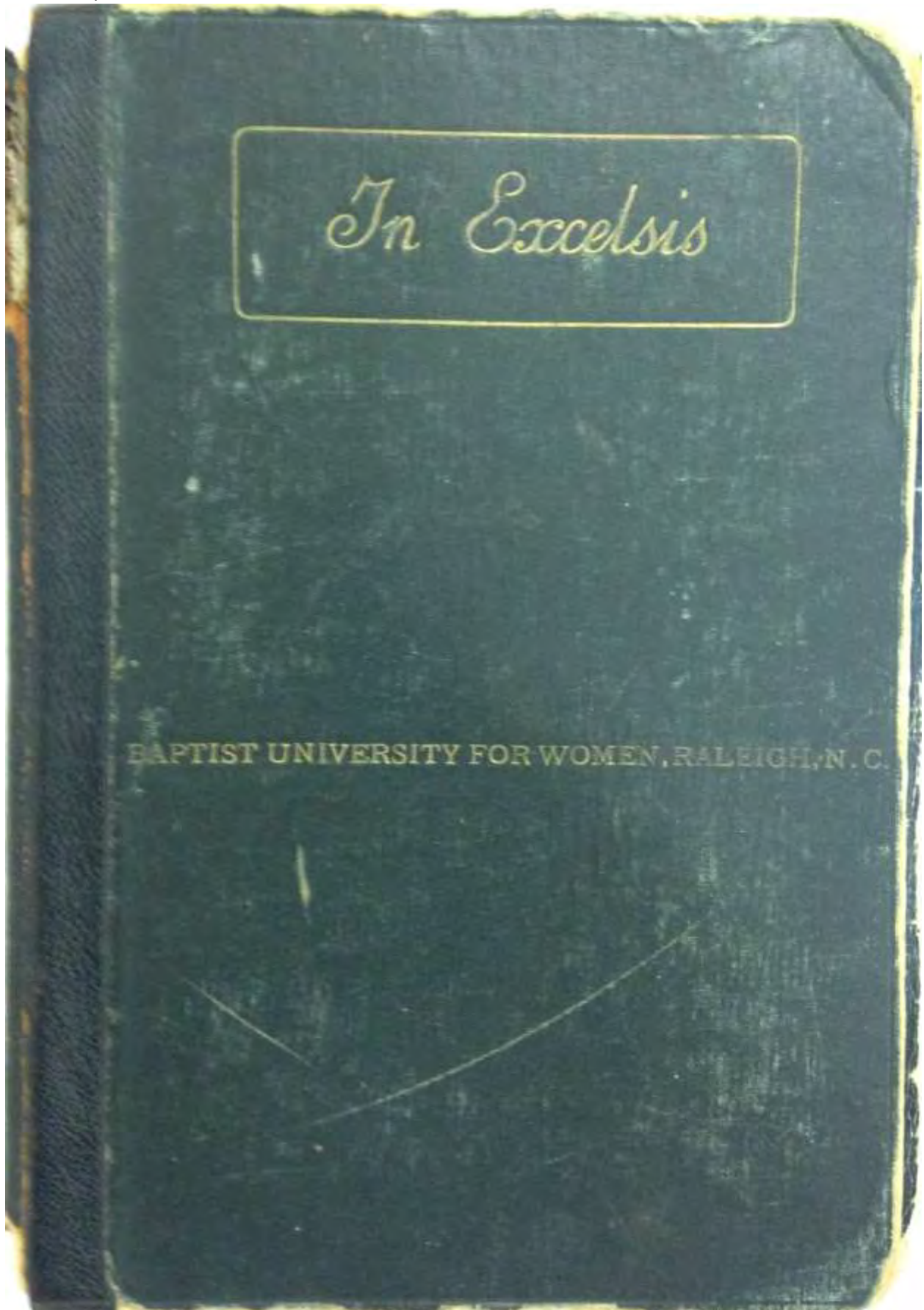

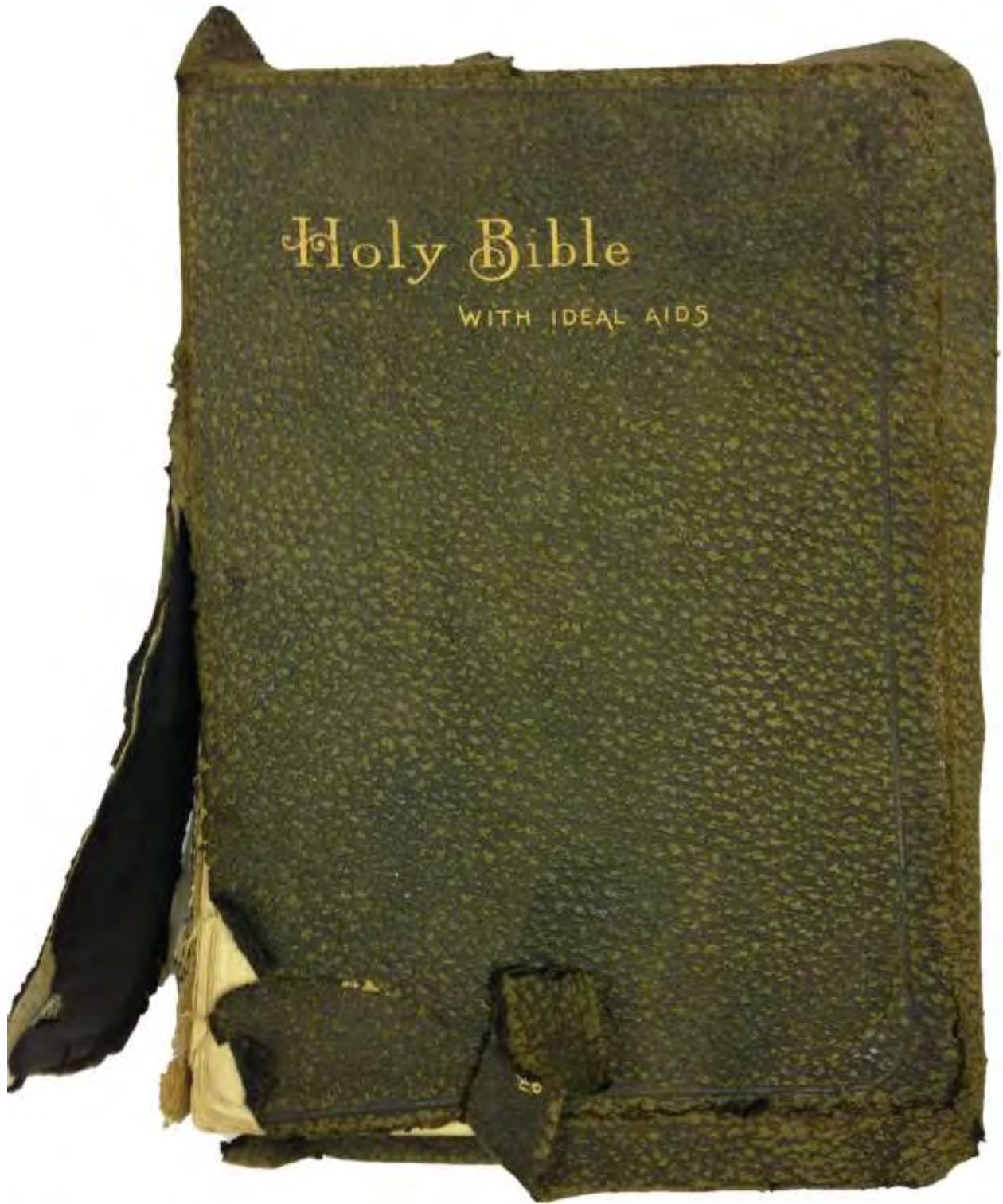
