

## Inserting Autoresponder Code into the Squeeze Page

1. Copy your Aweber code and put it into a notepad

2. Search with the following

```
<form method="post"
```

3. Separate the following code from the raw code (The code looks similar but not exactly same. The values will be different.)

```
<form method="post" action="http://www.aweber.com/scripts/addlead.pl">
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="listname" value="[your listname here]" />
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="redirect" value="http://www.example.com/thankyou.htm" />
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="meta_adtracking" value="custom form" />
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="meta_message" value="1" />
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="meta_required" value="name,email" />
```

```
<input type="hidden" name="meta_forward_vars" value="1" />
```

4. Keep this code aside

5. Open the Squeezepage index.html file in any html text editor

6. Find the following code

```
<form action="sendemail.php" method="post" name="myform" onsubmit="return validate()">
```

7. Replace the above code with the separated (your) autoresponder code and save it.

Note: With Getresponse you will have an option that your own customizable values which you will have to edit in the squeeze page. However we highly recommend Aweber as you list management service provider since they have the highest email delivery rate.
