Subject line: 7 Common Autoresponder Problems We Can Help You Solve (NEW Product)

PROBLEM #1: Procrastination

"I need a formula that eliminates perfectionism & procrastination"

I've included this problem first because it's overarching and I didn't really consider this as the main thing people would be struggling with. However, it was so common in your responses I need to address it.

lan has found that email writing procrastination is generally the result of one of two things: 1) a lack of habits and tactics to eliminate writer's block, or 2) a lack of ideas and formulas for writing fresh entertaining emails day after day.

In the 80/20 Email Copy Crash Course we address both of these.

lan believes it's possible to minimize the "writing fear" by using a specific set of strategies:

PROBLEM #4: Lack of ideas about what to write
