3 Software that every Serious Presentation Designer Must have in their Toolkit

Ever wonder:

- How to match colors used in a website or brochure with the colors in the presentation?
- How to get that exact shade of beautiful color that you see in an online ad?
- The Eye Dropper tool in PowerPoint only picks colors from within a presentation.

Tool 1

ColorPick Eye Dropper



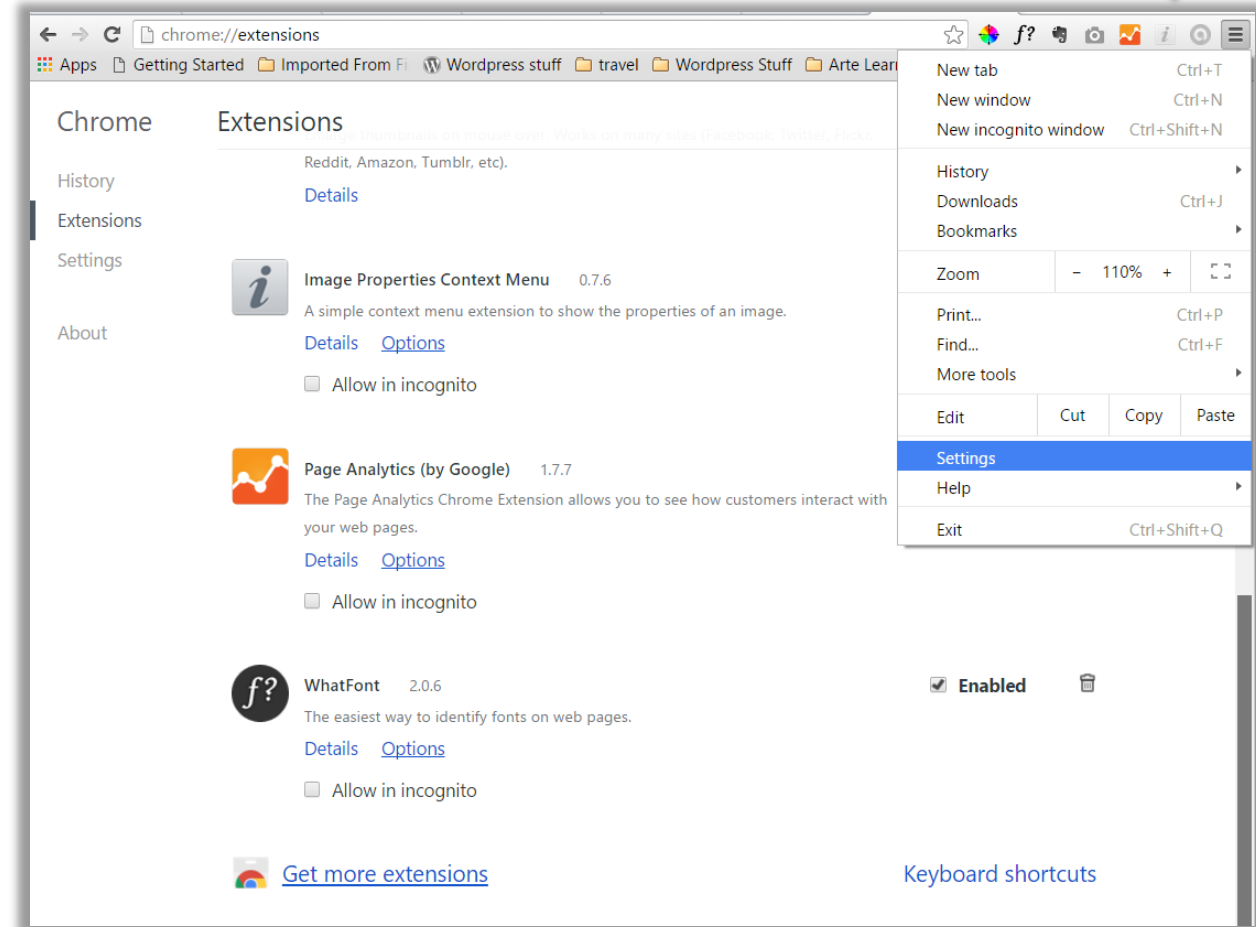
About ColorPick Eye Dropper



What is it: This is a great little tool that can provide the Hex, HSL & RGB values of any color.

It is an extension on Chrome browser.

How to Install It: Go over to your Chrome Browser > Customize > Settings > Extensions > Get More Extensions and search for the tool

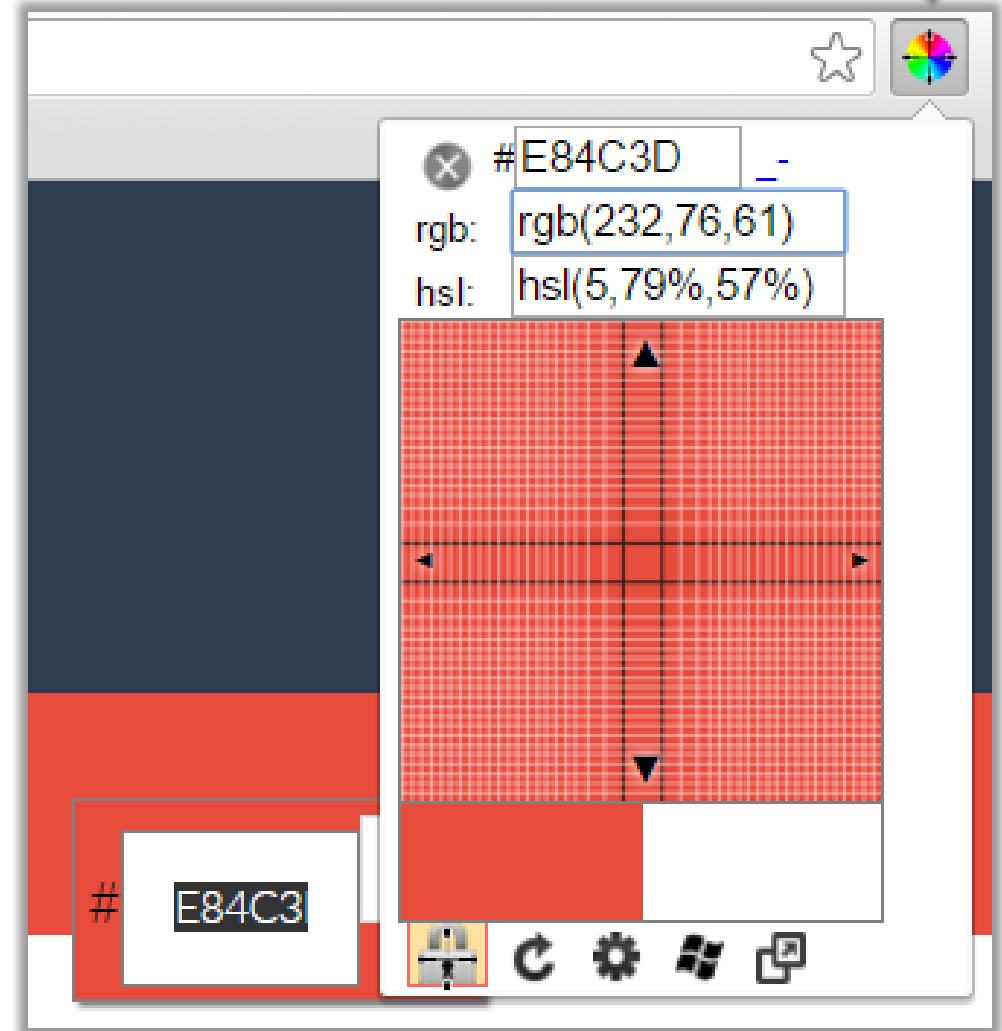


Using ColorPick Eye Dropper



How to Use it: When you see a color you like online, just click on the ColorPick tool and point at the color. It shows the color RGB codes that you can copy and paste into PowerPoint!

Note: PowerPoint has an EyeDropper tool too, to pick colors. This software however, is more easy and flexible to use.

Greenshot

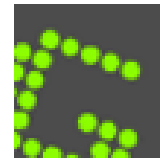


About Greenshot

What is it: This is a simple and easy to use Screenshot tool.

It works on both Windows and Mac

How to Install It: Go over to getgreenshot.org and download and install the file in your computer.

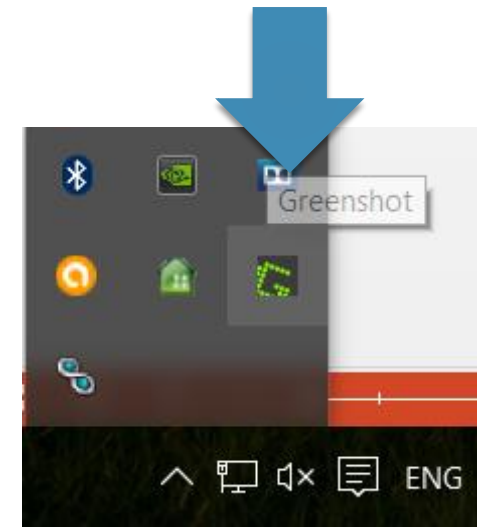

Using Greenshot

How to Use it: Click PrtSc button or find and click on the tool from your taskbar.

Select the specific area you want to copy. Then decide if you want to save it or save it to clipboard and then paste it.

	Capture window	Alt + Prnt scrn
	Capture full screen	Ctrl + Prnt scrn
	Capture Internet Explorer	Ctrl + Shift + Prnt scrn

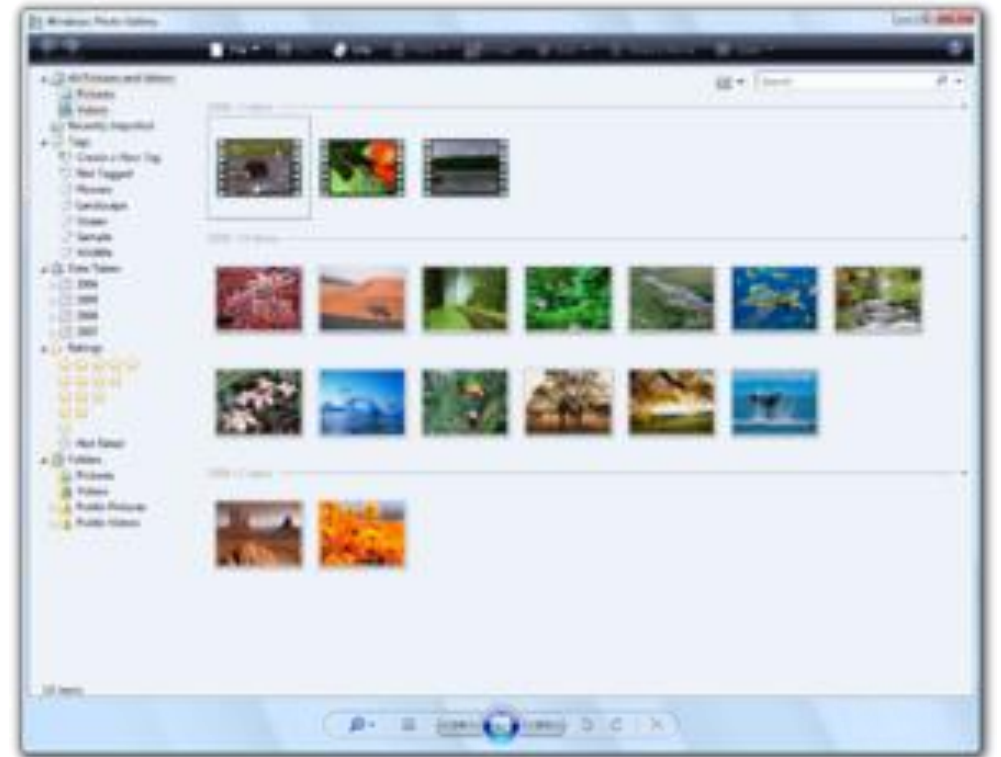


Using Photo Gallery
