Chameleon facts*:

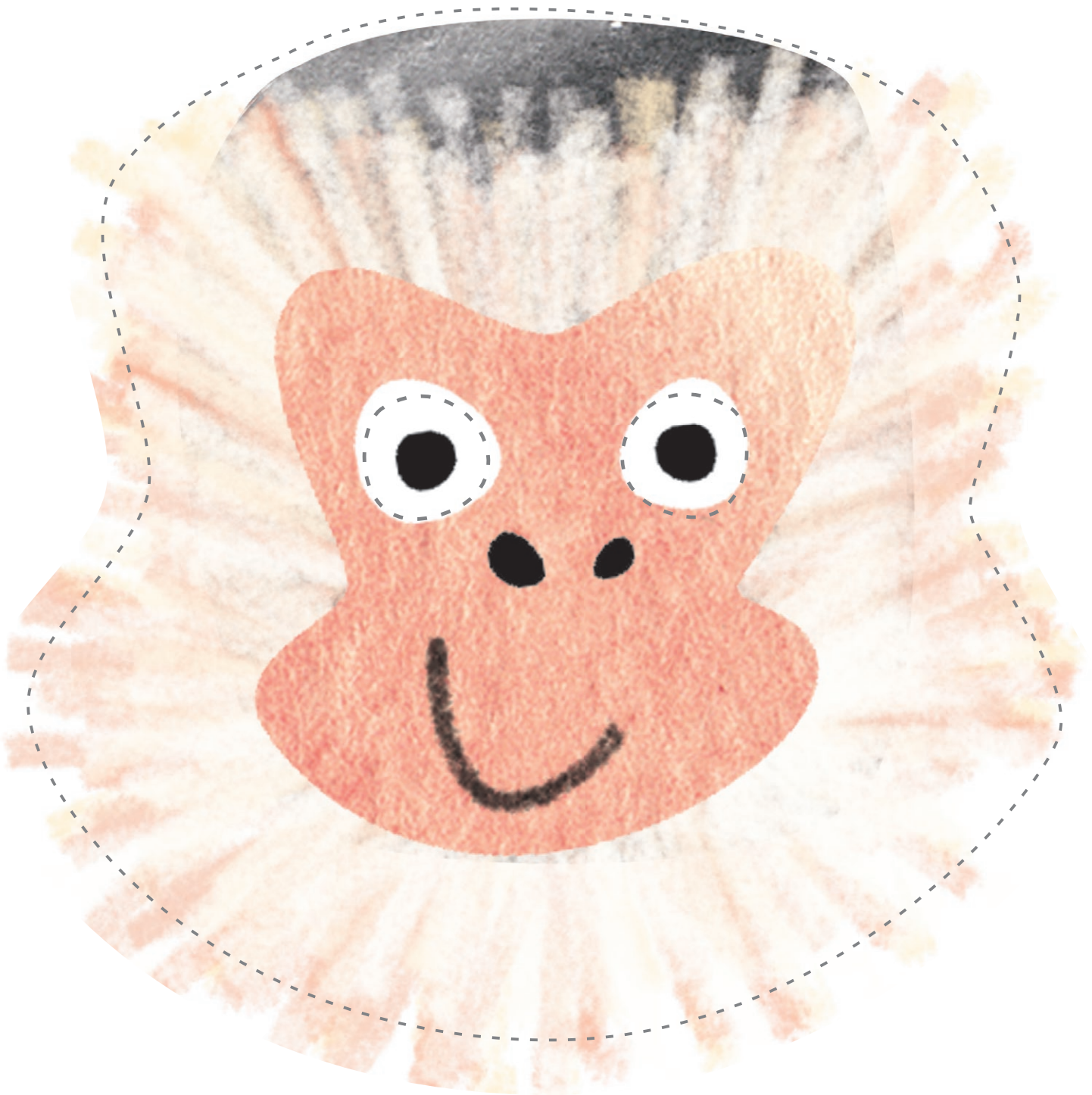


- Chameleons mostly live in the rain forests and deserts of Africa.
- Over 150 species of chameleons exist, ranging from the size of your thumbnail to that of a house cat.
- Their eyes can move in two different directions at once, giving the lizards a panoramic view of their surroundings.
- They often change color to warm up or cool down.
