PORTLAND, OR., November 8, 2017 — For a fifth and final year, All Classical Portland presents multi Grammy and CMA Award-winning violinist Mark O'Connor, performing with the Grammy Award-winning O'Connor Band, at the Arlene Schnitzer Concert Hall on Friday, December 22nd as part of the acclaimed *An Appalachian Christmas* tour. The performance features "heavenly" (*Associated Press*) interpretations of Christmas classics found on O'Connor's celebrated album of the same name, which is hailed by critics from the *Wall Street Journal*, *New York Times* and *Los Angeles Times* as a top 10 album of the holiday season. According to *The New York Times*, O'Connor's prolific career as a classical music composer and legendary bluegrass fiddler is "one of the most spectacular journeys in recent American music," having brought about collaborations with the likes of Yo-Yo Ma, Wynton Marsalis, Alison Krauss, Vince Gill, Earl Scruggs, and James Taylor.

Fresh off their **Grammy win for the 2017 Best Bluegrass Album**, the O'Connor Band delivers stunning vocal harmonies and sophisticated instrumentals that has won over fans of every musical style. Combining elements from classical, folk, and bluegrass, the band creates a fresh "Americana" sound that feels both modern and nostalgic. In the O'Connor Band, Mark is joined by his wife Maggie (MA, Peabody Institute of Music) on violin and harmony vocals, his son Forrest (former Tennessee State Mandolin Champion) on mandolin and lead vocals, and Forrest's fiancée, Kate Lee (frequent performer on the CMA Awards) on violin and lead vocals. National flatpick champion Joe Smart on guitar and bassist/banjoist extraordinaire Geoff Saunders (DMA, University of Miami) round out the ensemble.

Virtuosic, Seattle-based trumpeter Allen Vizzutti will perform an opening set accompanied by his wife, pianist Laura Vizzutti. Returning to share the stage with Mark and the band this year, Nancy Ives (principal cellist with the Oregon Symphony) makes a special guest appearance performing cello parts originally crafted by Yo-Yo Ma. An Appalachian Christmas will be a festive and joyous celebration from start to finish!

This will be the fifth and final year that All Classical Portland has partnered with Mark O'Connor to bring his holiday tour to Portland. "With all the hustle and bustle associated with this time of year, it's a real joy to find something so simple and pure as this holiday offering from Mark O'Connor."
