**Backline/Stage Requirements**

***Stage entry:***

All stages located higher than ground level should provide safe footing via steps onto and off the stage. The edges of the steps will be clearly demarcated with white tape. (Bad knees☺)

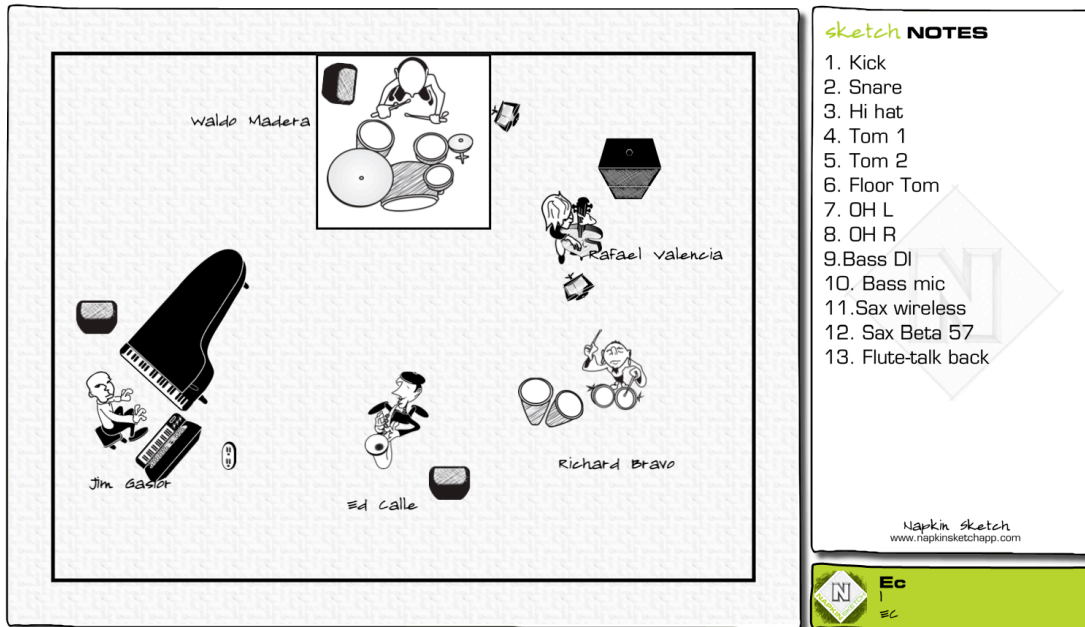

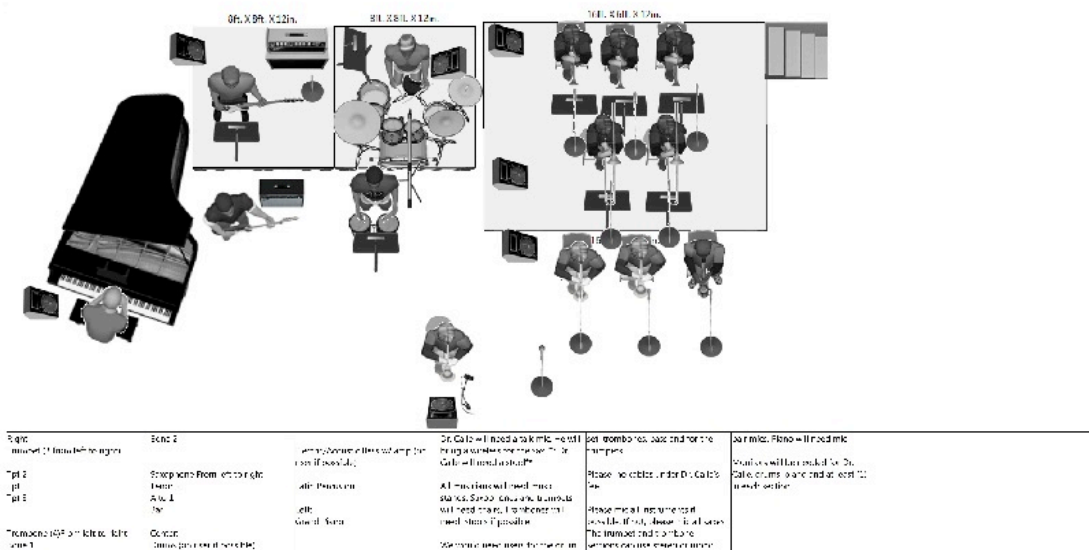

**Dressing Rooms**

When possible, the band will be provided five dressing rooms with mirrors, chairs, and tables. Alternatively, dressing room areas must provide comfortable chairs for at least 6 people, mirrors, and tables.
