GENERAL INFORMATION

CRUSTGARD thus saves on repeated waterings, prevents puddling and aerates the soil. Moisture remains in treated areas longer because it is not exposed to surface evaporation. CRUSTGARD, when added to liquid fertilizer, allows the plant nutrients to be carried to the rooting zone where they are immediately available. Seeds germinate faster in treated areas and transplants grow faster.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For hard and adobe soils and other compacted areas, nursery beds, lawns, golf greens and tee areas use:

Broadcast Application: Use 2-3 gallons per acre.

Banded Application: Use approximately 1-4 quarts per acre.

CRUSTGARD may also be added to liquid fertilizer at the above dosage.
