BACK

Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts.

EDGING: Work even in _____ until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Switch to _____ and work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

On your last row, place markers on each side of center ____ sts.

DECREASE ROW (RS): Work to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sm, work to next marker, sm, k2tog, work to end.

Work decrease row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

INCREASE ROW (RS): Work to marker, M1-r, sm, work to next marker, sm, M1-l, work to end.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts total. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO ____ sts at the beginning of the following 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every RS row ____ times: ____ sts remain.

Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE NECK:

NEXT ROW (RS): Work ____ sts, attach a new ball of yarn and BO center ____ sts, work to end.

Working both sides of the neckline at the same time, decrease 1 st at neck edge of every RS row twice. ____ shoulder sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending at the armhole edge.

NEXT ROW: BO ____ sts, work to end. Work 1 row even. BO rem sts.

FRONT

Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts.

EDGING: Work even in _____ until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Switch to _____ and work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

On your last row, place markers on each side of center ____ sts.

DECREASE ROW (RS): Work to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sm, work to next marker, sm, k2tog, work to end.

Work decrease row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

INCREASE ROW (RS): Work to marker, M1-r, sm, work to next marker, sm, M1-l, work to end.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Note: For some styles, neck shaping begins before armhole shaping.

ROMANTIC NECKLINE: Mark center of stitches.

MODERN V NECKLINE: Work ____ sts, pm, work to end.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO ____ sts at the beginning of the following 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every RS row ____ times: ____ sts remain.

SHAPE NECK: When piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row, shape neckline:

ROMANTIC NECKLINE—BOTH SIDES: Decrease 1 st at neck edge every ____ rows ____ times.

MODERN V NECKLINE—RIGHT SIDE: Decrease 1 st at neck edge every ____ rows ____ times.

MODERN V NECKLINE—LEFT SIDE: Decrease 1 st at neck edge every ____ rows ____ times.

CREW NECKLINE: NEXT ROW (RS): Work ____ sts, attach a new ball of yarn and BO center ____ sts, work to end.

Decrease 1 st at neck edge every row ____ times, then every RS row ____ times.

ALL NECKLINES: When all neck and armhole shaping is complete, ____ shoulder sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending at the armhole edge for each side.

NEXT ROW: BO ____ sts, work to end. Work 1 row even. BO rem sts.

SLEEVE

Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts.

EDGING: Work even in _____ until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Switch to _____ and work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

INCREASE ROW (RS): Knit 1, M1-r, work to last st, M1-l, knit 1.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts total. Work even until sleeve measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE SLEEVE CAP: BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO ____ sts at the beginning of the following 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every 3rd RS row ____ times, then every 2nd RS row ____ times, then every RS row ____ times.

BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows.

BO remaining ____ sts.
