BACK

Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts. Work even in _____ until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Switch to _____ and work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

On your last row, place markers on each side of center ____ sts.

DECREASE ROW (RS): Work to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sm, work to next marker, sm, k2tog, work to end.

Work decrease row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts remain. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

CASUAL LACE PANEL—OPTIONAL INSERT

Mark center ____ sts with a fresh set of markers. Work these sts in Dewdrop Lace (page 126), starting with Row 1, until back neck bind-offs.

INCREASE ROW (RS): Work to marker, M1-r, sm, work to next marker, sm, M1-l, work to end.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total: ____ sts total. Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO ____ sts at the beginning of the following 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every RS row ____ times: ____ sts remain.

Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE NECK:

NEXT ROW (RS): Work ____ sts, attach a new ball of yarn and BO center ____ sts. Work to end.

Working both shoulders simultaneously, decrease 1 st at neck edge of every RS row twice. ____ shoulder sts remain.

Work even until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending at the armhole edge for each side.

NEXT ROW: BO ____ sts, work to end. Work 1 row even. BO rem sts.

FRONT

Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts. Work even in _____ until piece measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Switch to _____ and work even until piece measures _____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.
On your last row, place markers on each side of center _____ sts.

DECREASE ROW (RS): Work to 2 sts before marker, ssk, sm, work to next marker, sm, k2tog, work to end.

Work decrease row every _____ rows _____ times: _____ sts remain. Work even until piece measures _____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

INCREASE ROW (RS): Work to marker, M1-r, sm, work to next marker, sm, M1-l, work to end.

Work increase row every _____ rows _____ times: _____ sts total. Work even until piece measures _____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

Note: For Bohemian style, neck shaping begins before armhole shaping starts. For Casual and Sporty styles, neck shaping begins before armhole shaping is complete. Please read ahead.

SHAPE ARMHOLES: BO _____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO _____ sts at the beginning of the following 2 rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every RS row _____ times: _____ sts remain.

SHAPE NECK: When piece measures _____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row, shape neck:

BOHEMIAN STYLE—BOTH SIDES: Mark center _____ sts.

NEXT ROW (RS): Work to marker, attach new ball of yarn and BO center sts, work to end.

Working both sides of neckline at same time, decrease 1 st at neck edge every _____ rows _____ times.

CASUAL STYLE: Mark center _____ sts.

NEXT ROW (RS): Work to marked sts, attach a new ball of yarn and BO to the next marker, work to end.

Working both side of neckline at same time, decrease 1 st at neck edge every RS row _____ times, then every other RS row _____ times.

SPORTY STYLE: Mark center _____ sts.

NEXT ROW (RS): Work to marked sts, attach new ball of yarn and BO to next marker, work to end. Working both sides of neckline at same time, work straight for 3" (7.5 cm), then continue shaping neckline as follows.

BO _____ sts at the neck edge of the next row.

Decrease 1 st at neck edge every row _____ times, then every RS row _____ times.

ALL STYLES: When all neck and armhole shaping is complete, _____ shoulder sts remain. Work even until piece measures _____ from CO edge, ending at the armhole edge.

NEXT ROW: BO _____ sts, work to end. Work 1 row even. BO rem sts.

SLEEVES

BOHEMIAN STYLE: Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), MC, and needles one size

smaller, CO ____ sts. Work even in Stockinette st until piece measures 1" (2.5 cm) from CO edge, ending with a RS row. Change to larger needles and knit 1 WS row to create turning ridge.

Work even in MC and Stockinette st until sleeve measures ____ from turning ridge, ending with a WS row.

CASUAL STYLE: Using long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts. Work even in Garter st until sleeve measures 1" (2.5 cm) from CO edge.

Switch to Dewdrop Lace (page 126) over center ____ sts, keeping remaining sts at sides (if any) in Stockinette st, and work until lace measures approximately 2" (5 cm), ending with a WS row.

Switch to Stockinette st and work 2 rows even.

INCREASE ROW (RS): K1, M1-r, knit to last stitch, M1-l, k1.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total. ____ sts total. Work even until sleeve measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SPORTY STYLE: Using CC and long-tail cast-on method (or a different one, if you prefer), CO ____ sts.

Work even in 2x1 rib and CC until piece measures ½" (1.5 cm) from CO edge. Switch to MC and continue until piece measures 1" (2.5 cm) from CO edge.

CREATE THUMBHOLE: *Work on RS row for right sleeve, WS row for left sleeve.*

Work ____ sts, attach a new ball of yarn and BO ____ sts, work to end. Working both sides at the same time, work even until thumbhole measures 1¾" (4.5 cm).

On your next row, work to thumbhole, CO ____ sts to close the hole, work to end with same ball of yarn. Cut second ball of yarn.

Continue in MC and rib until sleeve measures 7" (18 cm) from CO edge. Switch to Stockinette st.

INCREASE ROW (RS): K1, M1-r, knit to last st, M1-l, k1.

INCREASE ROW (WS): P1, M1-p, purl to last st, M1-p, p1.

Work increase row every ____ rows ____ times total. ____ sts total. Work even until sleeve measures ____ from CO edge, ending with a WS row.

SHAPE SLEEVE CAP: BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 2 rows. BO ____ sts at the beginning of the following two rows. Decrease 1 st at each end of every 3rd RS row ____ times, then every other RS row ____ times, then every RS row ____ times.

BO ____ sts at the beginning of the next 4 rows.

BO final ____ sts.
