I understand:

- 1. The Commercial Pesticide Applicator Permit will be on a two year cycle, and corresponds with my CCA cycle;**
- 2. My Commercial Pesticide Applicator Permit may be revoked if I lose my CCA certification for any reason (deficient in CEUs, non-payment of CCA dues, violation of ethics agreement, etc.), or if I do not renew my pesticide permit with the Department of Agriculture on the specified date;**
- 3. I do not have to report CEU's to the Department of Agriculture (the ceu's will be handled through the CCA program); and**
- 4. If I lose or drop my CCA certification or do not renew my Commercial Pesticide Applicator Permit by the specified date, the only way I can recapture my pesticide permit is by taking the exam(s) administered by the Pesticide Management Section and then maintaining CEUs through the Alabama Department of Agriculture and Industries.**
