



#### Page 2

Tang'rnisqaq nukallpiaq pisurtaallria taquka'anek ingrit akulitni. Angutruaq cucunait'sqaq pisurtaallria isuwiinek imarmi. The good-looking man always hunted bears in the mountains. The old, ugly man always hunted for seal in the ocean.

#### Page 3

Allriluq erneq, nukallpiak angit'llriik pisuryakacamek. Taumi-llu Qateryuk mit'llria Tang'rnisqam canianun. Tang'rnisqam pingaken'illkii Qateryuk.

One day, the men returned after they hunted. Then a ptarmigan landed next to the good-looking man. The good-looking man did not like the ptarmigan.

#### Page 4

Mal'ugnek cingkii, qayaraurluku, "Awa maken, qa'i-cali taiyuten maa'ut?" Pinga'iwagni cingkii, Qateryuk angqiarlluku.

Two times he pushed her away, yelling "Get away, why did you come here?" On the third time he pushed her, hurting the Ptarmigan.

#### Page 5

Taumi-llu Qateryuk agellria Angutruamen. Angutruaq ugaullria, cali pingaklluku. Atakuu, Angutruaq negtalillria, neregkwarluku Qateryuk.

Then she went to the old man. He was kind, and he liked her. Later, the old man made a nest for her, and fed the ptarmigan.

#### Page 6

Erneq tamiin angitaallriik pisuryakacamek. Ciqlluaq p'rirtengia'allria tekicamek. Neq'rkangq'rllriik, cali pikiyutaq nutaasqaq ell'uni.

Every day they would return after they hunted. The sod house was clean when they arrived. They had food, and a new gift was there.

Allriluq erneq, Angutruaq tang'ryukii kina ciqlluani et'a. Angutruaq yaamam tunuani nuyamaluni. Taumi tang'rkii kina iluani! Arnaq cucunasqaq ciqlluami et'llria! Taugum atkua qat'sqanek culugnek canamallria.

One day the old man wanted to see who was in his sod house. He hid behind a rock. He saw someone inside! There was a beautiful woman in the house! Her coat was made of white feathers.

Angutruaq it'llria ciqlluamen. Tang'rkii Qateryum amia natermi, taumi teglegkii. Arnaq cimikaunilnguq qateryut'stun awa'i. Kesiin, arnaq, Angutruaq-llu pingakut'llriik. Angutruam kasuskii. Erneq tamiin arnam wiini pikiyutalirluku, keniyulluku.

He entered the sod house and saw her ptarmigan skin on the floor, and stole it. She could not change back into a ptarmigan.

However, they liked each other. The old man married her. Each day she made him gifts and cooked for him.

The good-looking man was jealous of him.
That night, the good-looking man killed the old man. The good-looking man told the woman,
"I want to marry you." The woman told him,
"I came here to marry you, but you hurt me. I will not marry you!"

#### Page 10

Tang'rnisqam niu'ulluku, "Agningaituten natmen, nuliqsa'uciqamken."

Taumi-llu Qateryum tang'rkii amini! Arnam nukallpiaq cingkii, niuglluni, "Tawa-ruq, nuliqsa'uningaitaarpenga!"

The good-looking one told her, "You will not go anywhere, I will make you my wife."

Then she saw her ptarmigan skin! She pushed him away and said, "Absolutely not, you will not make me your wife!"

#### Page 11

Taumi-llu qateryum amini ugcuulluku pingayunek. Allriluq, mal'uk, pingayun, taumi all'uku. Tengllria ciqlluamek. Tang'rnisqaq nukallpiaq kiimi awa'i. Kinguani nuliituq, angayuwinani.

Then she shook her ptarmigan skin three times. One, two, three, then she put it on. She flew out of the sod house. The good-looking man is alone now. In the end he has no wife, and no friend.
