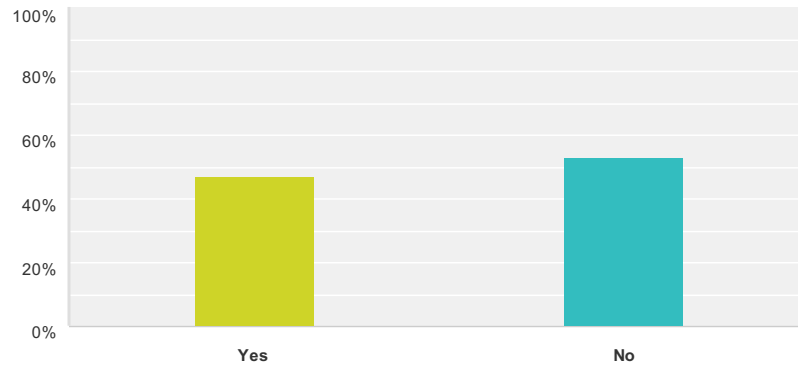


# Delegate Eligibility Survey

Answered: 356 Skipped: 4

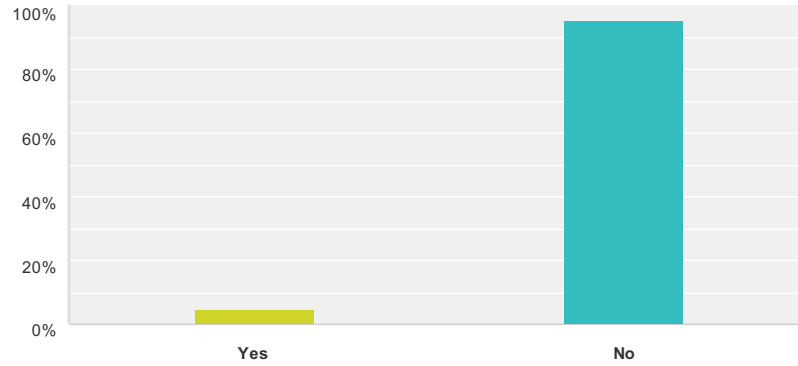

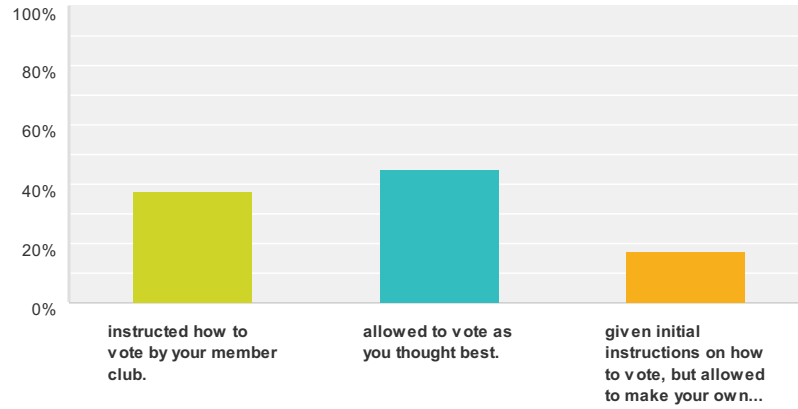

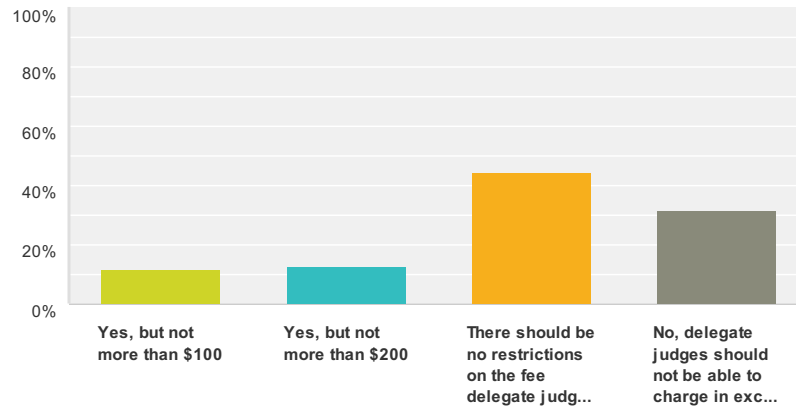

Answered: 260 Skipped: 100

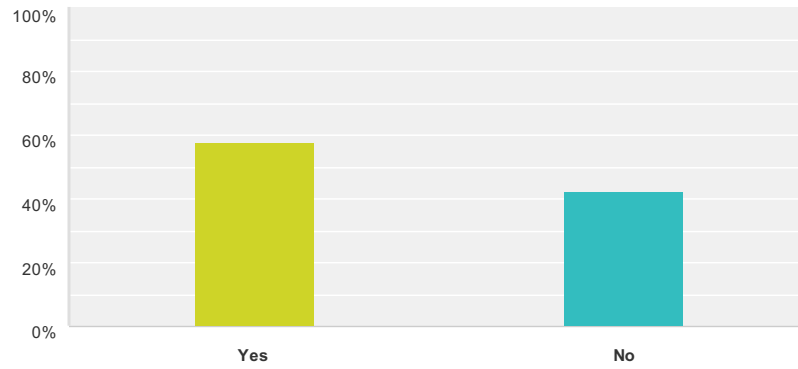

Answered: 258 Skipped: 102

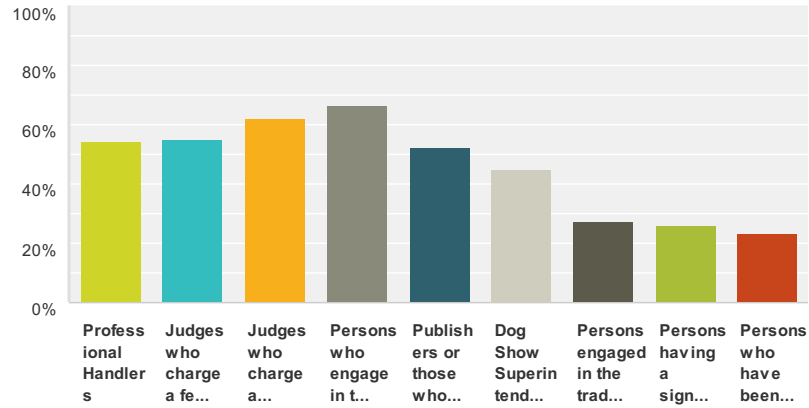

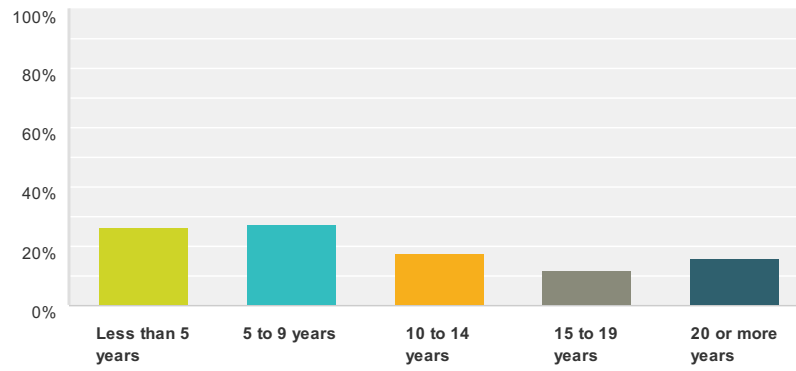

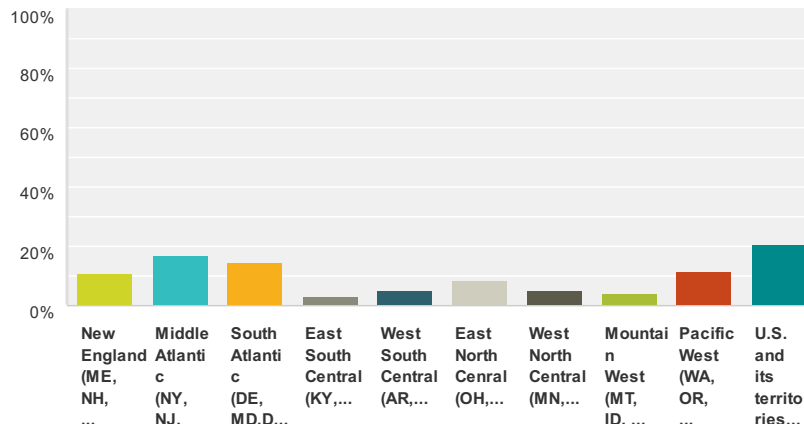
