"Observations"

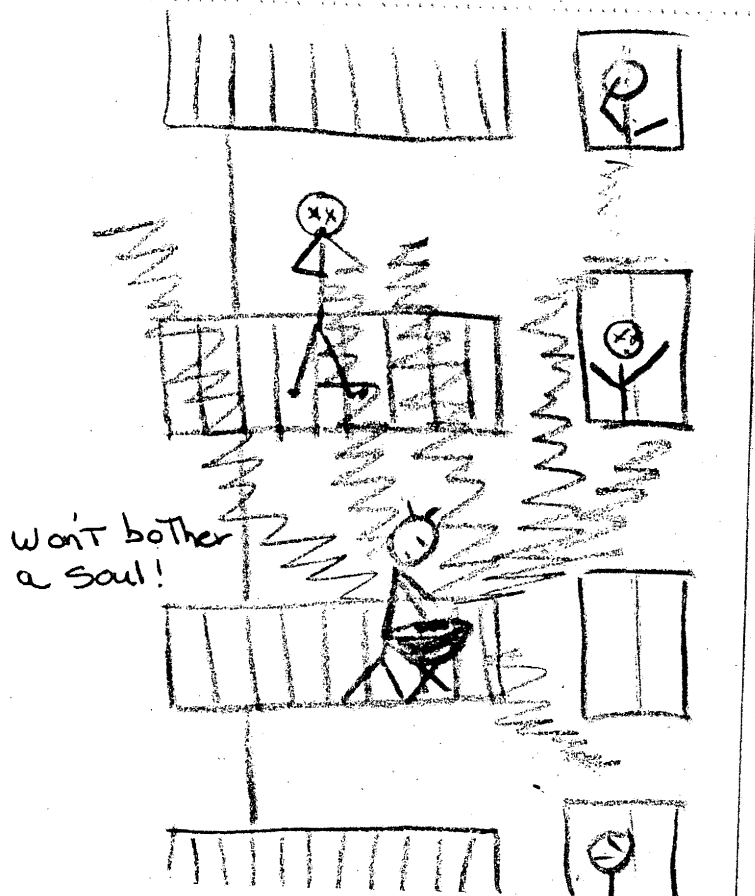
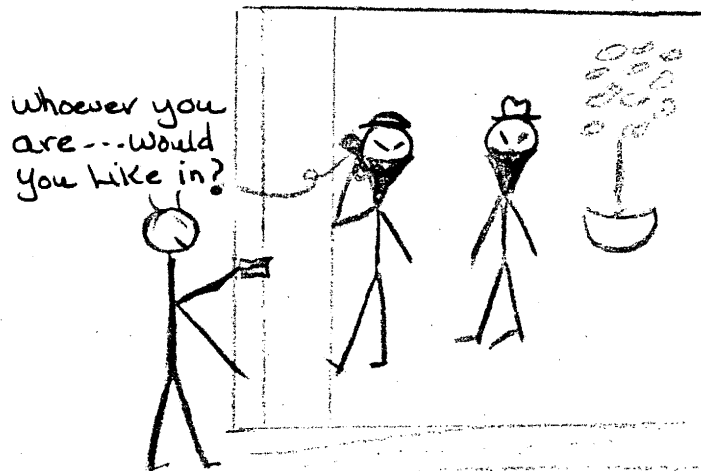
