


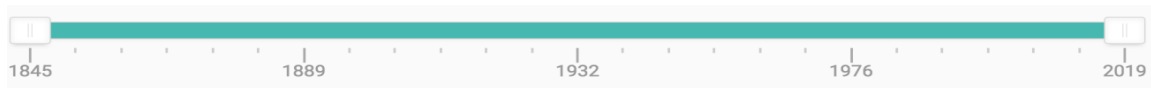



Instructions: How to use Jewish Communities map

1. Each marker  represents a location of a Jewish Community, which was in existence between 1500 and 2000 years
2. Click on a marker to reveal summary information about a particular location. There will also be a link where you can access further details.
3. Circles with numbers within represent a cluster of markers. Blue circles  contain 10 or fewer markers while yellow circles  contain more than 10 markers. Click on the circle to zoom in on the area and see all the markers within it.
4. Use the "+" and "-" on the lower right of the map to zoom in and out. Use the "Reset Zoom" button on the lower left to reset the zoom level.
5. The timeline slider below the map can be used to show a snapshot of communities during specific periods



Move the left slider to indicate the start date for displaying communities, then move the right slider to indicate the end date

As each slider is placed, the map will add or remove communities so that only communities that were active during the selected period will be visible

6. The search feature below the map on the right can be used to search for a community by name
7. Navigate through the results list by using the "<" and ">" buttons
8. Click on the target  symbol to the left of a result to bring up the info for that location
