On Wednesday, June 28th, 2017 at 5:55 pm, the Clinton County Sheriff's Office was notified of a person that had been struck by a northbound Canadian Pacific train.

Deputies responded to the area of 468th Avenue and 170th Street (Bulger's Hollow) and discovered that a male subject had in fact been struck by the train.

The Clinton County Medical Examiner's Office was called to the scene and pronounced the person deceased. The victim was identified as 42 year old Dale Robert Sherman from Fulton, Illinois.

Assisting at the scene were members of the Clinton County Sheriff's Office, Canadian Pacific Police Services, Andover Ambulance and Fire and the Clinton County Medical Examiner's Office.
