



# Department Organization Chart Prior to 2015






- The Clinton Police Department purchased and implemented a new, state of the art, records management system, which included a computer aided dispatch system.






# NATIONAL INCIDENT BASED REPORTING SYSTEM


# Deputy Police Chief

- Position created and filled in 2016, reporting directly to the Chief of Police.
- Assumes command of the department in absence of Chief of Police.
- Makes recommendations to the Chief of Police on hiring, promotion, transfer, disciplinary actions and department effectiveness and ensures responsiveness to the community.
- Facilitates communications between the community and the Clinton Police Department, in order to enhance the department's effectiveness and to accomplish the department's mission.
- Attend meetings and represent the department and Chief of Police, as assigned.



# Administrative Sergeant

- Position was formerly known as Services Supervisor, which was primarily responsible for equipment and training.
- The Administrative Sergeant is now responsible for supervising the Public Service Officer and office staff. The Administrative Sergeant also coordinates all department training and equipment.
- Implements and maintains all department computer hardware and software (squad cars and offices).
- Responsible for records management software, department policy and procedure manual (electronic) and Records Division.



# Animal Protection Officer

- Position created in 2018 (Currently taking applications and conducting interviews). Position to be filled in fall of 2018. Intend to make the position a certified officer within 24 months.
- APO will patrol city streets for animals running at-large; apprehend animals in violation of city ordinance and transport animals to Clinton Humane Society
- APO will respond to and investigate complaints of animal cruelty and neglect to animals.
- The APO will promote responsible pet ownership.
- The APO will issue citations for violations relating to the health, safety and welfare of animals. They will also cite for violations of animal licensing.
- The APO will also perform additional duties as assigned.



# Police Reserves Unit

- 5 Police Reserves to supplement department needs.
- Trained by modules certified by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy.
- Attend Departmental training along with sworn officers
- Reserves officers can perform most police functions under the supervision of a sworn department member.
