'MNPINK1' PINK POPCORN®

PP#25,792, CPBRAAF

- USDA Zones 3 to 7
- 5'H x 5'W at 10 years
- Vase-shaped habit
- Acidic soil; even moisture; full sun; approximately 800 chill hours
- Medium sized cream to pink berries with a darker pink blush ripen early to mid-season
- True blueberry taste and aroma
- Red fall color
- Self-pollinating
- Edible fruit production and/or ornamental landscape



VS.

Vaccinium corymbosum
PINK LEMONADE

- USDA Zone 5; will produce farther south than many traditional blueberry cultivars
- 5'H x 5'W at 10 years
- Vigorous, upright habit
- Acidic, well-drained soil that is rich in organic matter; full sun to partial shade; approximately 200 chill hours
- Early berries are translucent white, maturing to bright pink; ripen mid through late season
- Berries are sweet, with a firm, clear texture
- Red fall color
- Borders, mass plantings and fruit production
