

## Objective 36

### Explores drama through actions and language

Related Objectives: 3a, 4, 5, 8a, 8b, 13, 16b, 30

## What You Do

---

1. Invite the students to join you in a circle.
2. **Say**, “Think of a sport. Imagine what it looks like and how people move while playing it.” **Give the students a moment to think about their chosen sport.**
3. Ask one student to name the sport he or she thought of and invite everyone to act it out together.
4. Continue the game by going around the circle and inviting the other students to act out their chosen sport.

- Compare the students' movements and discuss the differences in each sport along with the equipment used.
- Encourage the students to think of other sports to identify and act out. Write the students' ideas on chart paper.
- Ask the students to identify whether each sport is played indoors or outdoors (or both) and whether it is a team sport or an individual sport.
- Invite the students to identify the beginning letter sound of their favorite sport, e.g., /b/ for baseball, /s/ for soccer.
