

## Objective 19

### Demonstrates writing skills

#### a. Writes name

Related Objectives: 7b, 8b, 11a, 13, 15b, 20a, 21a, 21b, 22a

## What You Do

---

- 1. Give each student a sticky note and a marker, crayon, or pencil. Ask the students to write their names on their sticky notes.**
- 2. Prompt the students to place their sticky names on various items around the room using the following as examples:**
  - Something that begins with the same sound as your name.
  - Something that has a pattern on it.
  - Something that is longer than 5 inches.
  - Something that is next to the bookshelf.
  - Something that is green and round.
- 3. Continue the activity for several rounds.**

- Ask the students to write their first and last names on the sticky notes.
- Prompt the students to work together to add a certain number of sticky notes to an item: “Place [eight] sticky notes on something [green] and [five] on something [blue].”
- Leave the students’ sticky names posted around the classroom and repeat the activity throughout the day during transitions or other appropriate moments.
