What You Do

- 1. Look for opportunities to notice when a child helps the group in some way, e.g., a young infant hands you a book to put in the book basket at cleanup time; a toddler gets another child's blanket for him at nap time; a 2-year-old passes out napkins at snack time.**
- 2. Sing to the tune of "Row, Row, Row Your Boat."**

Thank you, thank you, thank you, [Max].
It's good that you were here.
We'd like to show you our thanks,
Let's give a thank-you cheer!

- 3. Applaud and cheer for the child.**

- **After singing the song, encourage children to use the phrase “thank you,” as appropriate, throughout the day.**
