Uses classification skills

Related Objectives: 1a, 4, 8b, 11a, 15b, 15c, 21a, 21b, 26, 29

What You Do

- 1. Invite the students to pretend they are on a trip to the flea market.**
- 2. Say,** “We are going to pretend we’re at the flea market. A flea market is a place where you can buy all kinds of different things. Listen to my instructions and I will tell you what type of item to buy.”
- 3. Describe a characteristic of the item that you want the students to buy,** e.g., something that is an octagon, something that is taller than you, something that has stripes.
- 4. Encourage the students to name the items they choose.**

- Give the students additional prompts for items to buy using the following as examples:

Something that starts with the /sh/ sound

Something that has three syllables

Something that is next to a shelf

Something that makes you happy

Something that has your name on it

Something that starts with the same sound
as [*poodle*]
